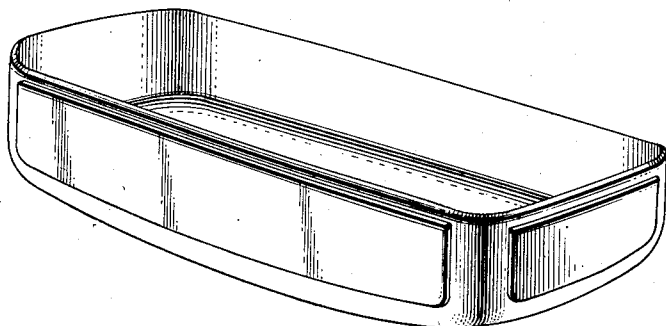
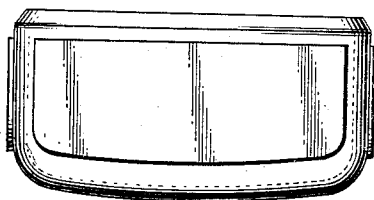

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles A. Ferguson, a citizen of the United States, residing at San Antonio, in the county of Bexar and State of Texas, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Base Protectors for Golf Bags, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
