DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and right front perspective view of a postal scale showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereto;

 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.













