FIG. 4 is a left side view of the activity mat with the flap in the first position;

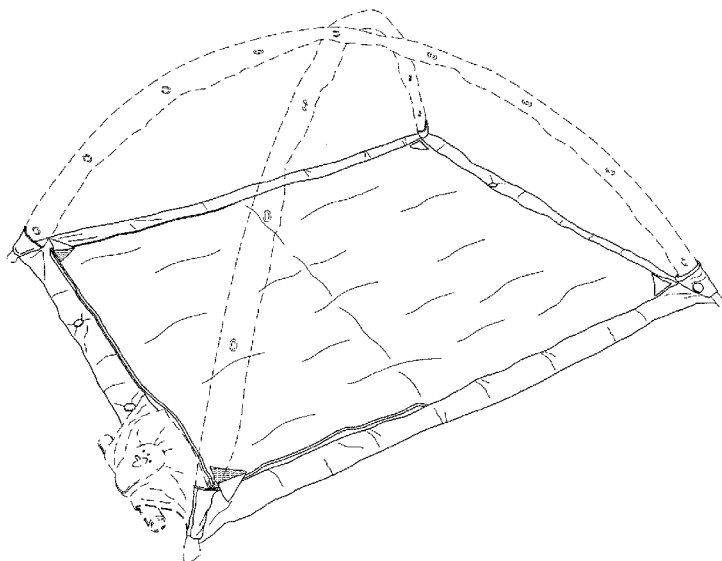
FIG. 5 is a top view of the activity mat with the flap in the first position;

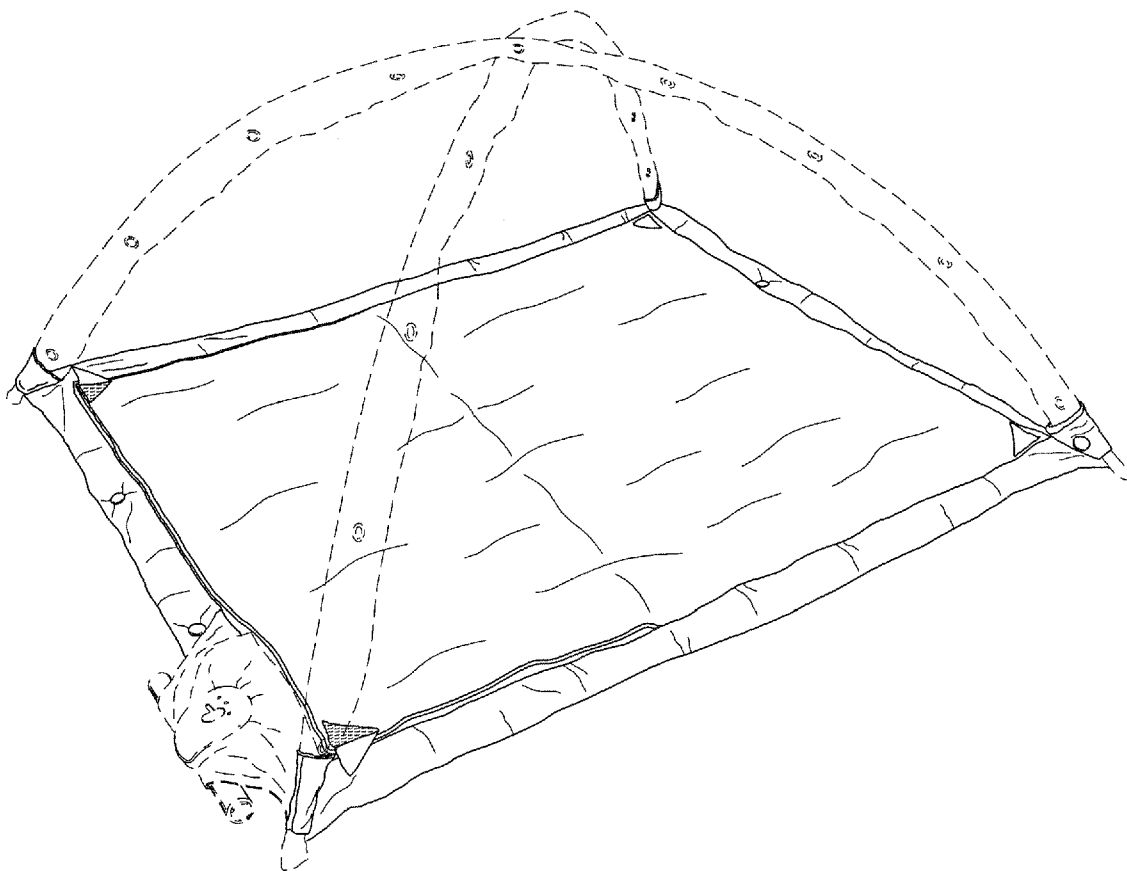

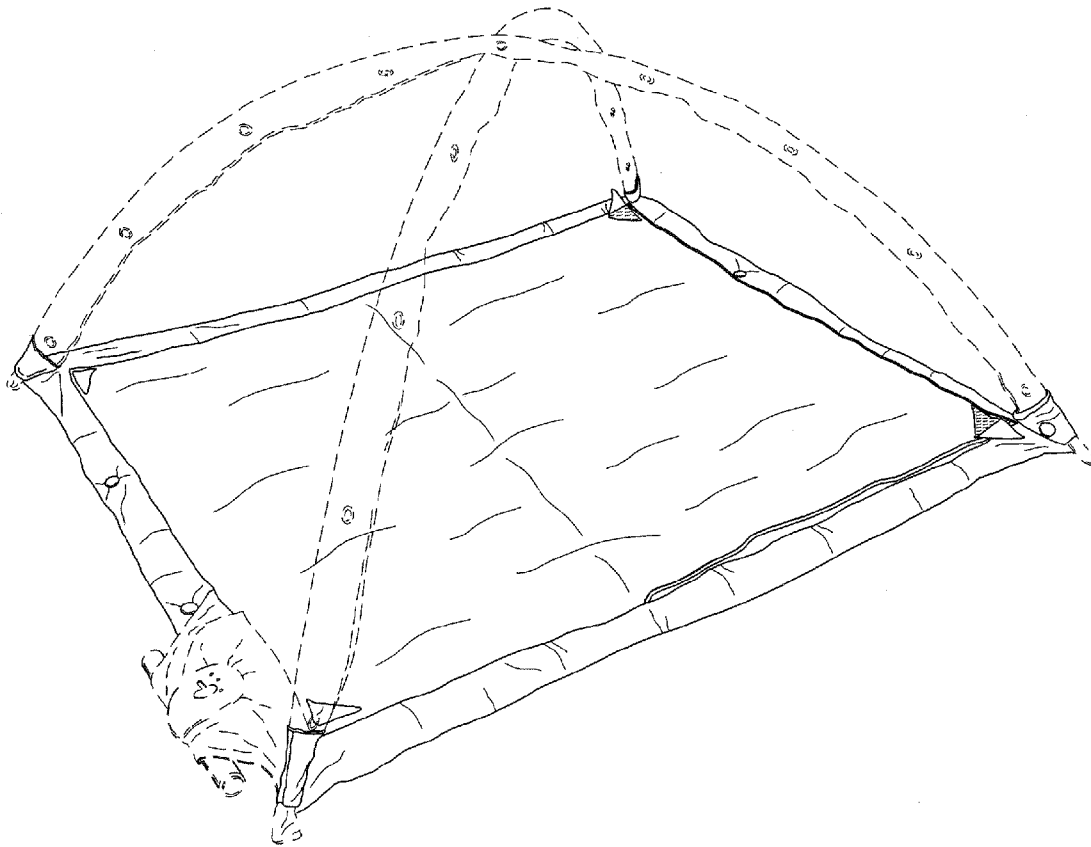

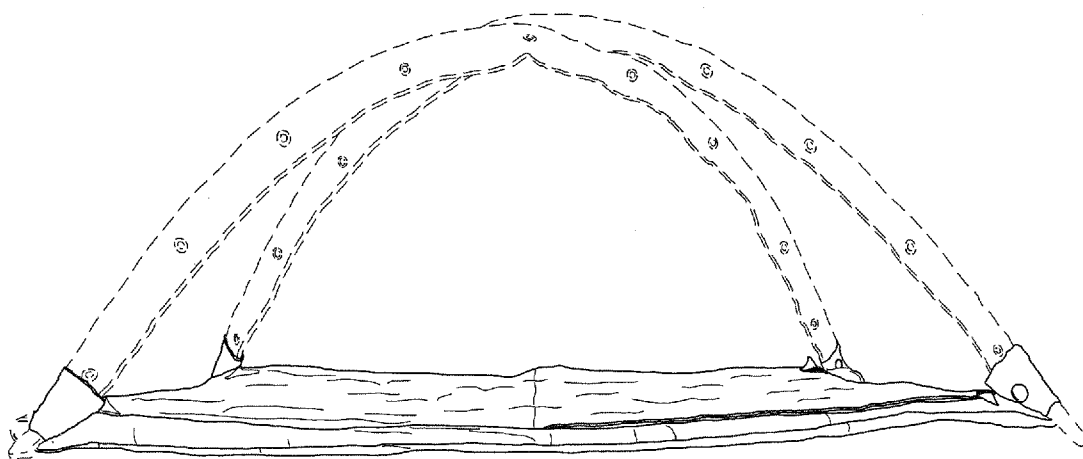

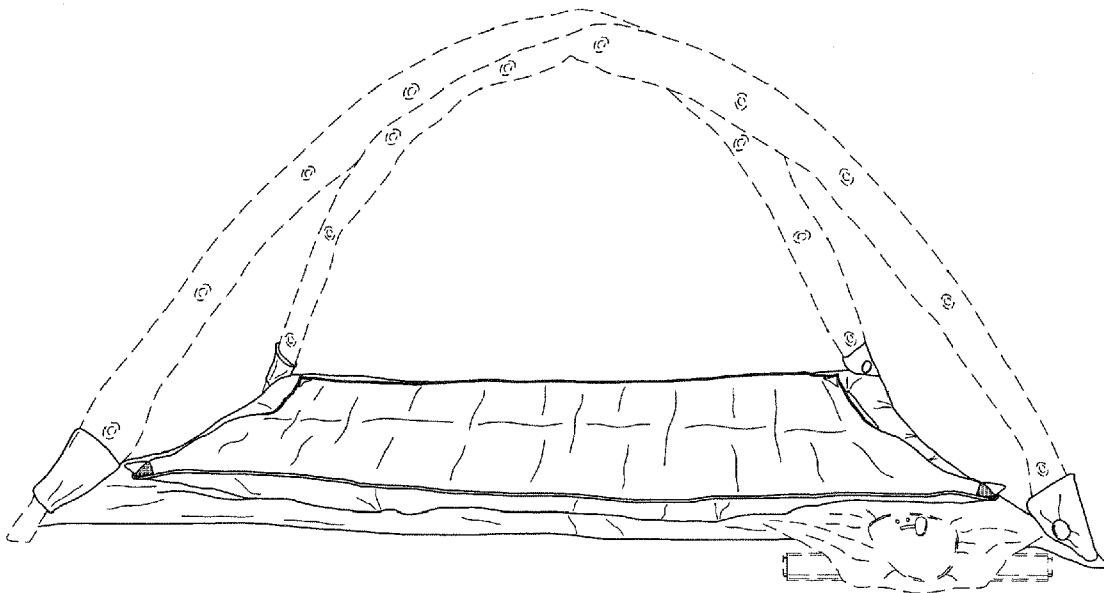

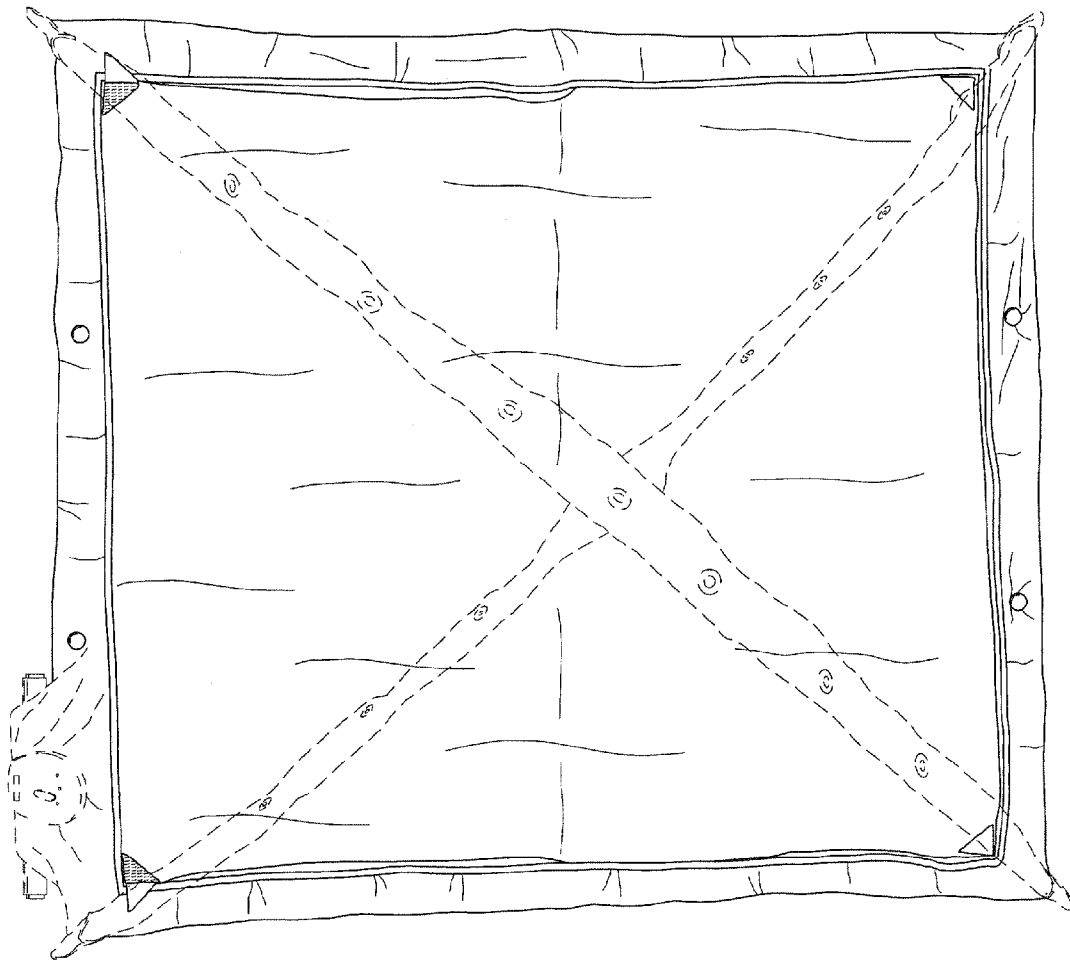

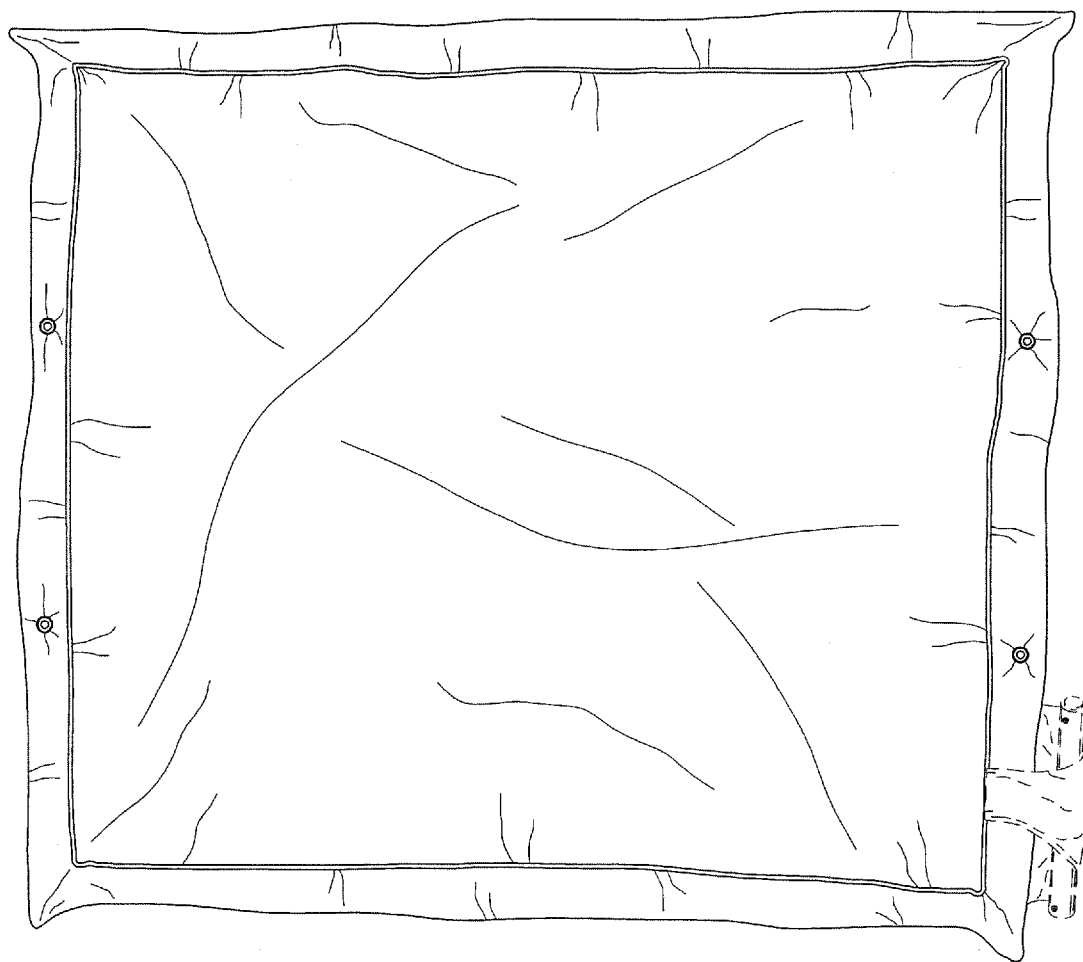

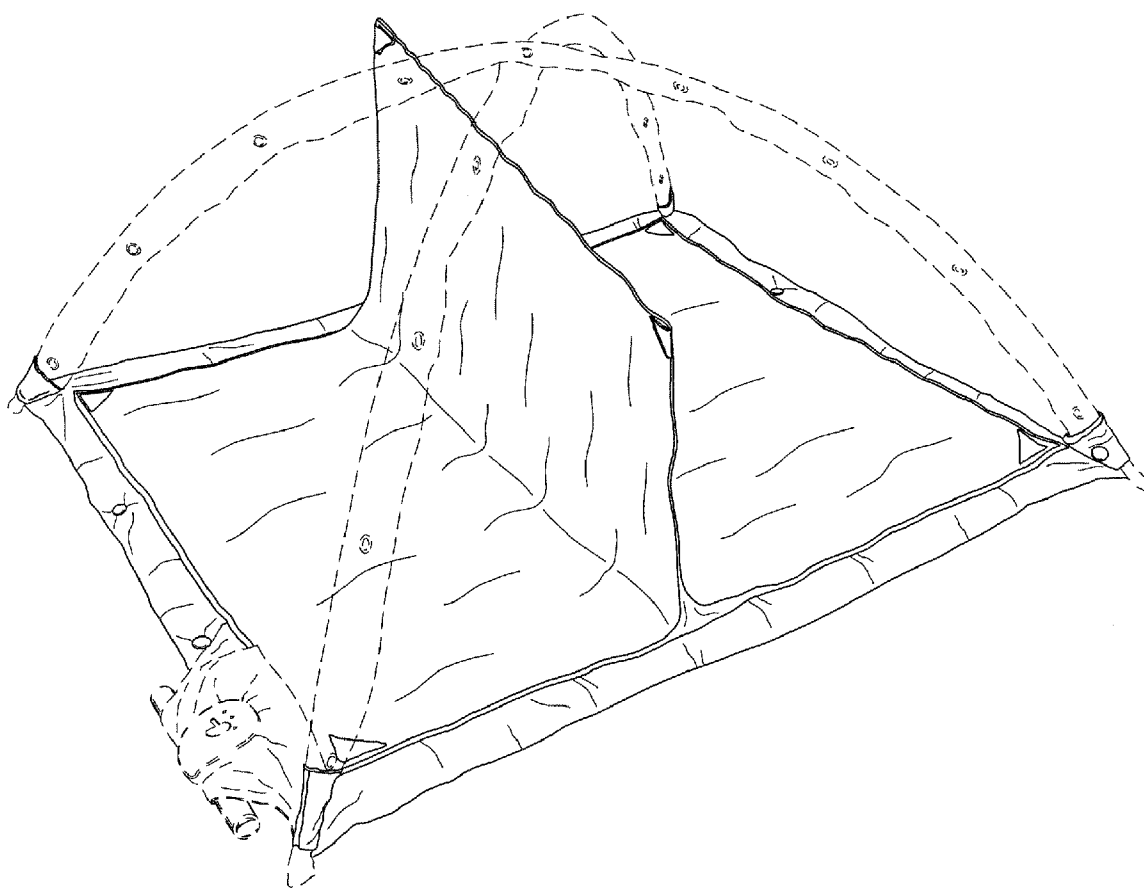
