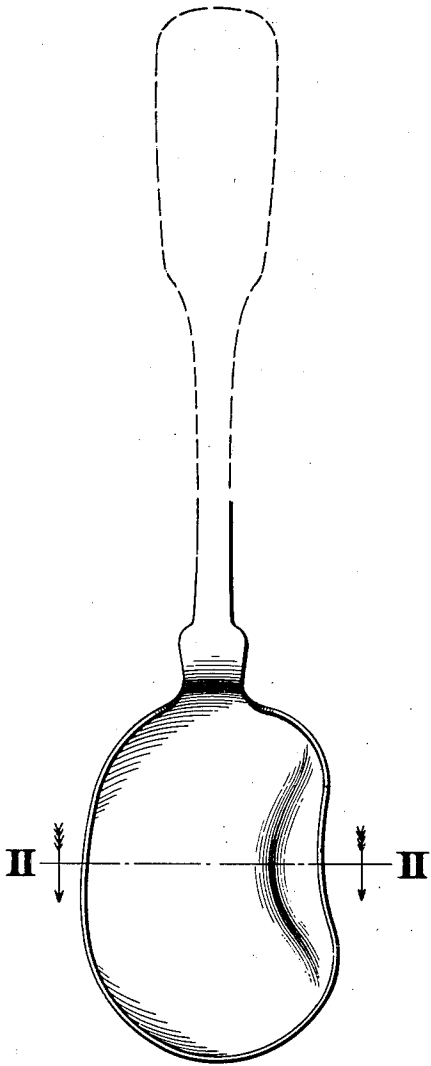

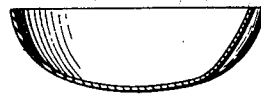

DESIGN FOR A SPOON

Charles H. W. Foster, Marblehead, Mass.

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles H. W. Foster, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Marblehead, in the county of Essex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Spoon, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a spoon showing my

new design, the handle thereof being conventional and shown in dash lines, and

Fig. 2 is a view in cross-section along the line II—II of Fig. 1.

The essential features of my design reside in the parts shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a spoon, substantially as shown and described.
