CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a combined stackable container and lid, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a combined stackable container and lid, showing a first embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an exploded front elevational view of FIG. 1, the rear elevational view, left-side elevational view, and right-side elevational view all being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is an exploded top plan view of FIG. 1 with the lid shown adjacent to the container;

FIG. 5 is an exploded bottom plan view of FIG. 1 with the lid shown adjacent to the container;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view of FIG. 1, taken along lines 6-6 of FIG. 4;

FIG. 7 is an exploded perspective view of a fifth embodiment thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is an exploded front elevational view of FIG. 7, the rear elevational view, left-side elevational view, and right-side elevational view all being identical thereto;


FIG. 10 is an exploded top plan view of FIG. 7 with the lid shown adjacent to the container;

FIG. 11 is an exploded bottom plan view of FIG. 7 with the lid shown adjacent to the container; and,

FIG. 12 is a cross-sectional view of FIG. 7, taken along lines 12-12 of FIG. 10.

The broken lines showing an additional stacked container in FIG. 1 depict environmental matter and form no part of the claimed design.





















