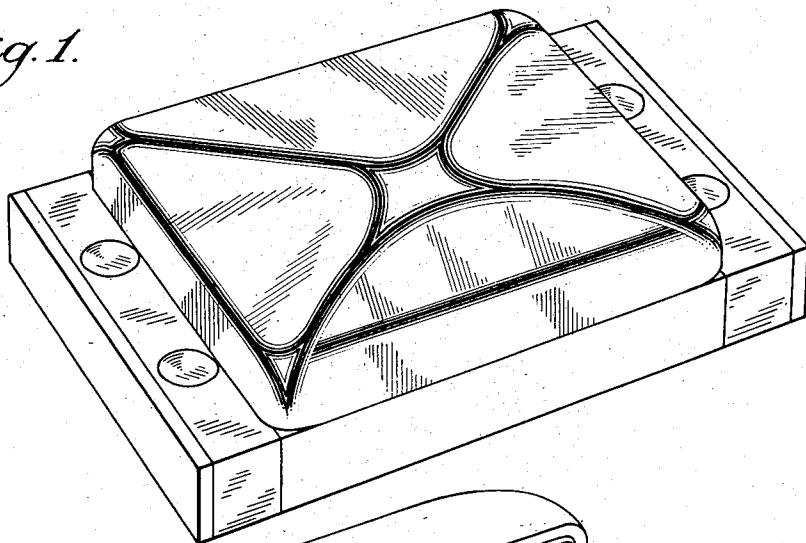
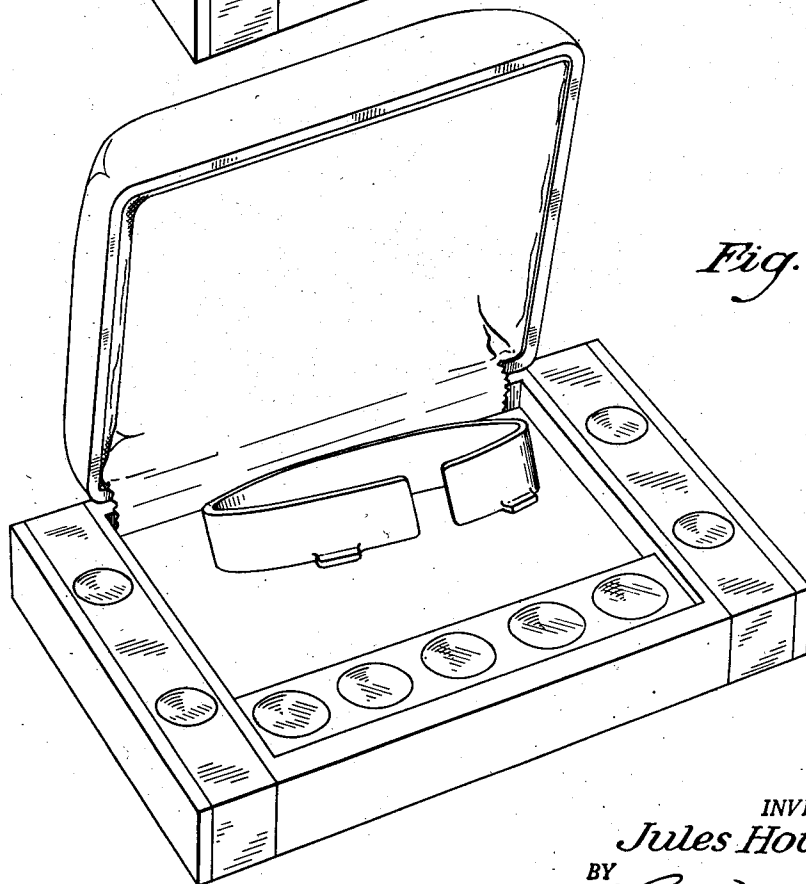

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jules Howard, a citizen of the United States, residing at San Jose, in the county of Santa Clara and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Box for Wrist Watch and Parts Therefor, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a box embodying my new design and shown in closed condition;

Fig. 2 is a perspective view similar to that of Fig. 1 with the lid thereof in open condition.
