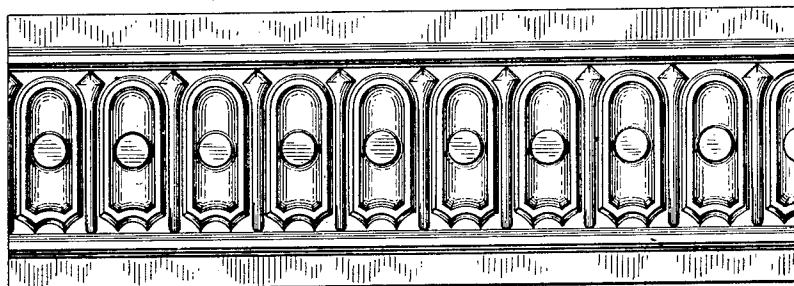

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN L. WHITE, a citizen of the United States, residing at the borough of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings, city and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Metallic Band or Border, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a band or border showing my new design, and Fig. 2 is an end elevation of the same.
