

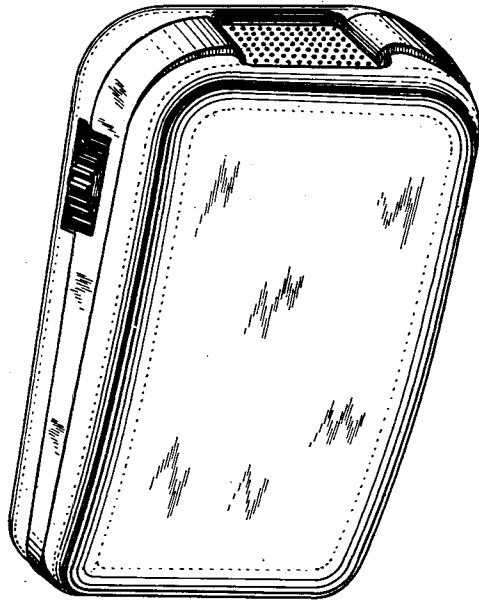

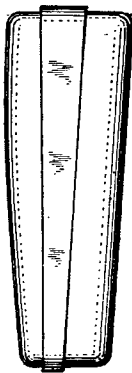

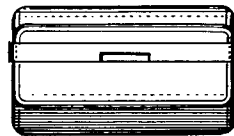

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Leland A. Watson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Minneapolis, in the county of Hennepin and State of Minnesota, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Hearing Aid, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

In the drawings:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a hearing aid, on a substantially enlarged scale showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is an elevational view on an actual size scale showing the side of the hearing aid opposite to that shown in Fig. 1.

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view on the scale of Fig. 2. The rear surface is plain.
