

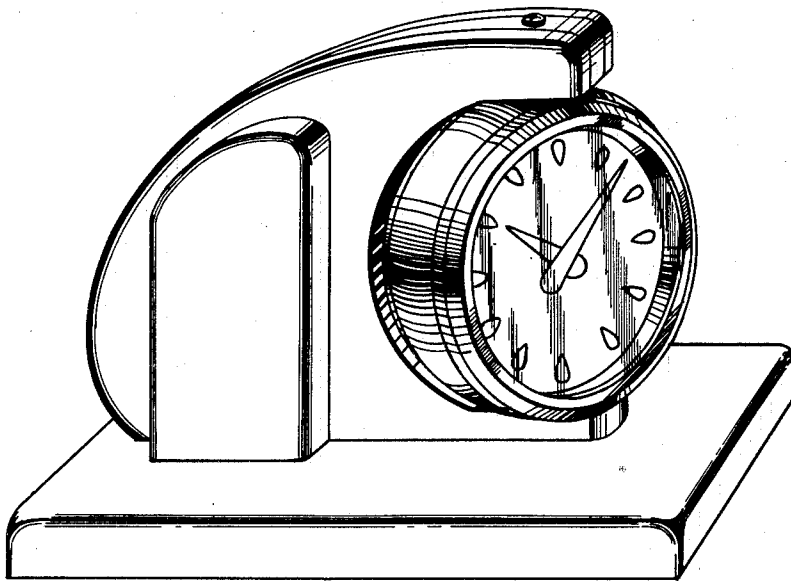

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles Wesley Sheldon, a citizen of the United States, residing in Lancaster County, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Desk Clock, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

The figure is a side perspective view of a desk clock showing my new design, the opposite side being substantially the same in appearance as the side shown except for the clock member, the rear of which is conventional.
