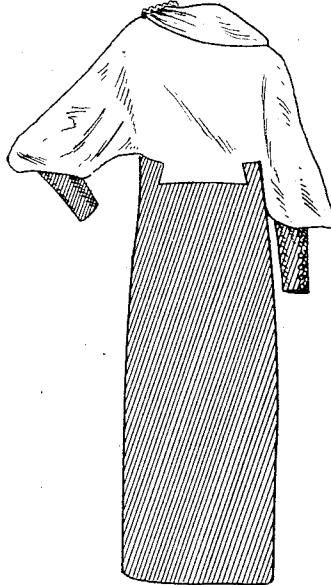
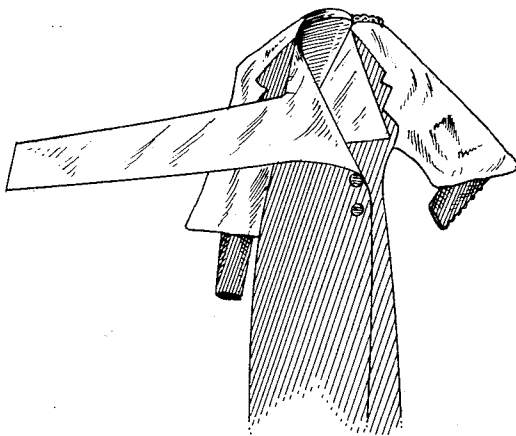

DESIGN FOR A COAT

Application filed April 9, 1932. Serial No. 43,452. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DOROTHY LONG, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of New York, borough of Manhattan, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented the new, original, and ornamental Design for a Coat, of which the following is a specification.

Reference is had to the accompanying drawings forming part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a front perspective view of a coat showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a rear perspective view of the coat shown in Figure 1.
