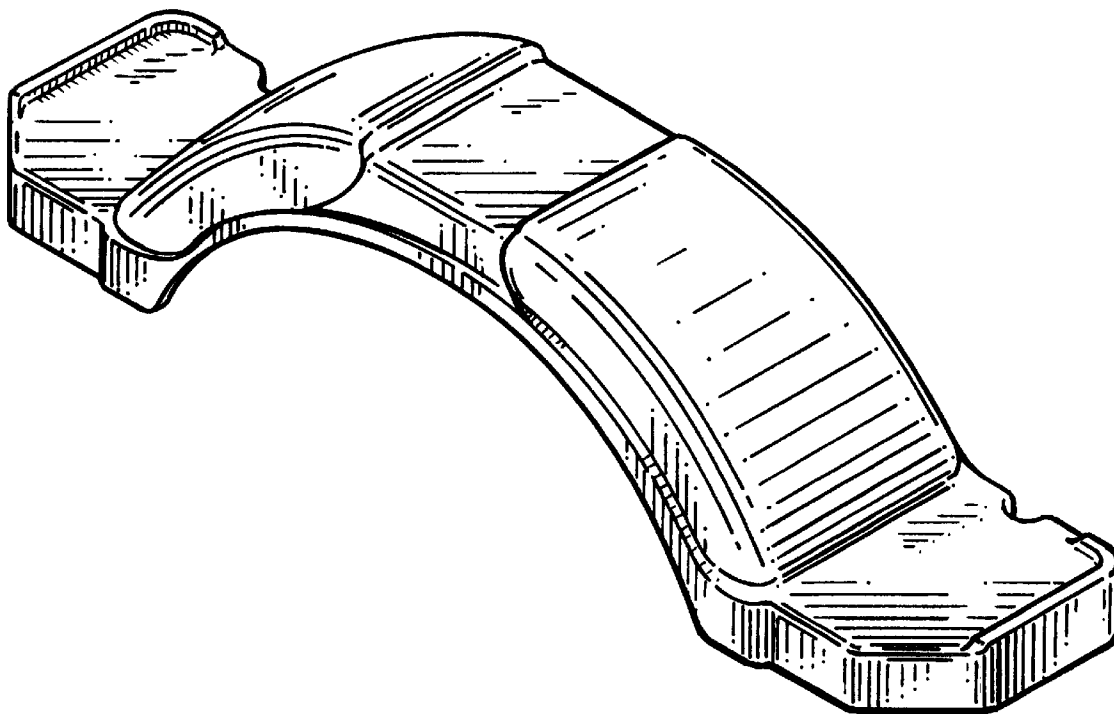
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a trailer fender showing my new design;

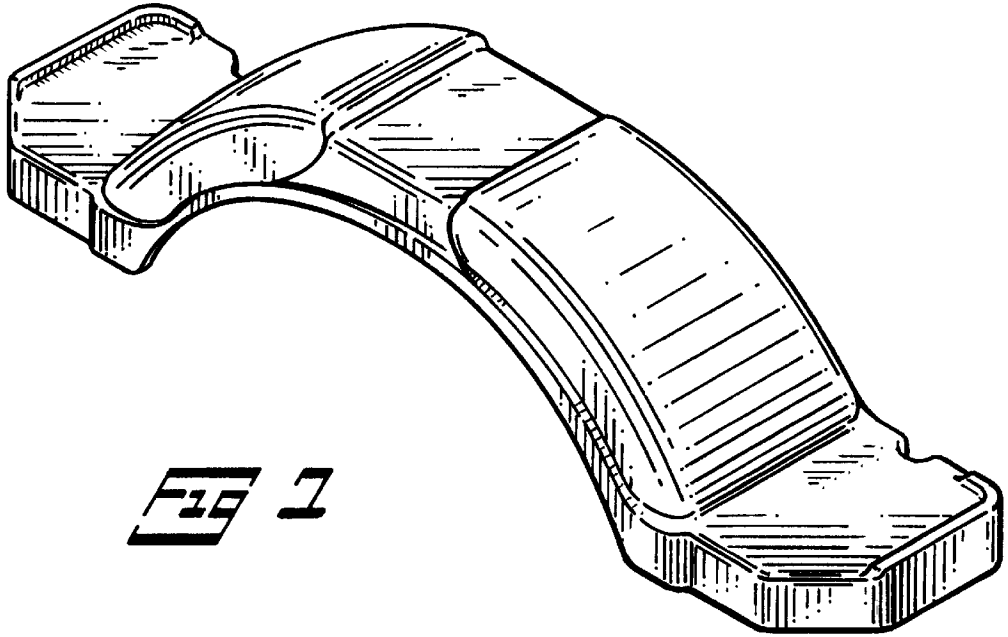

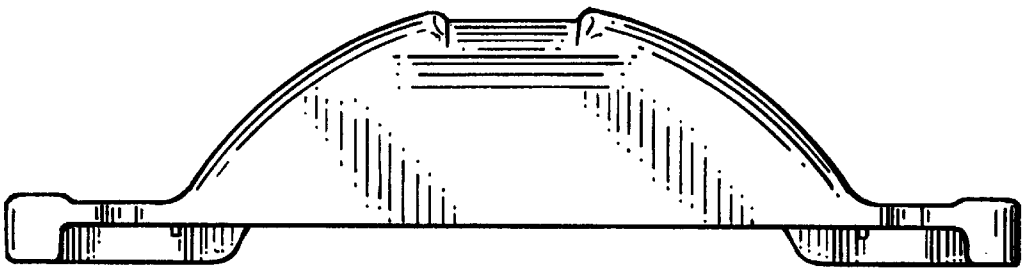
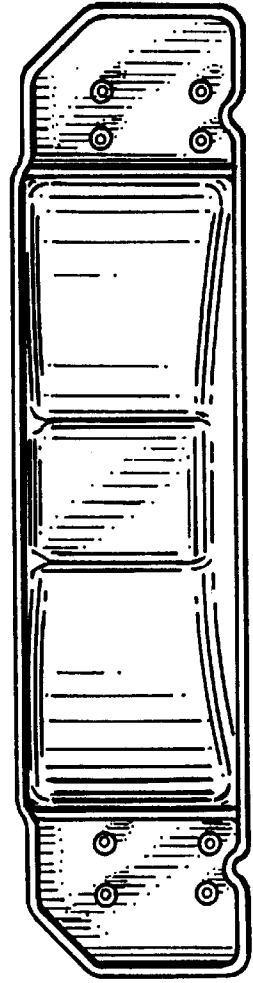
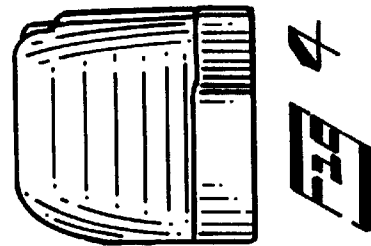
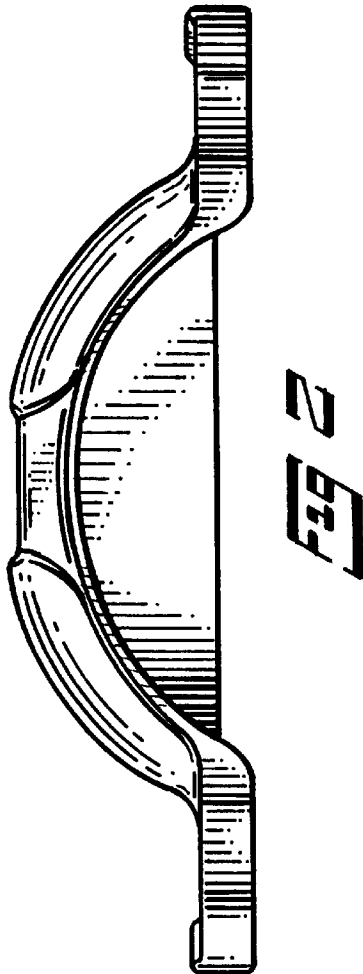
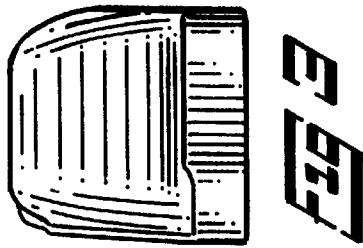
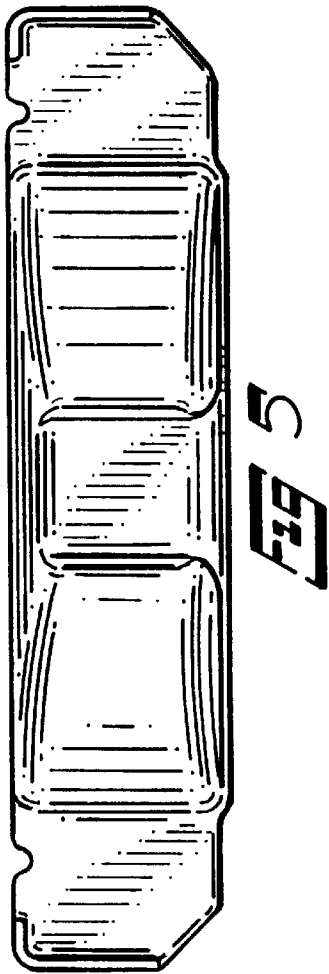
