

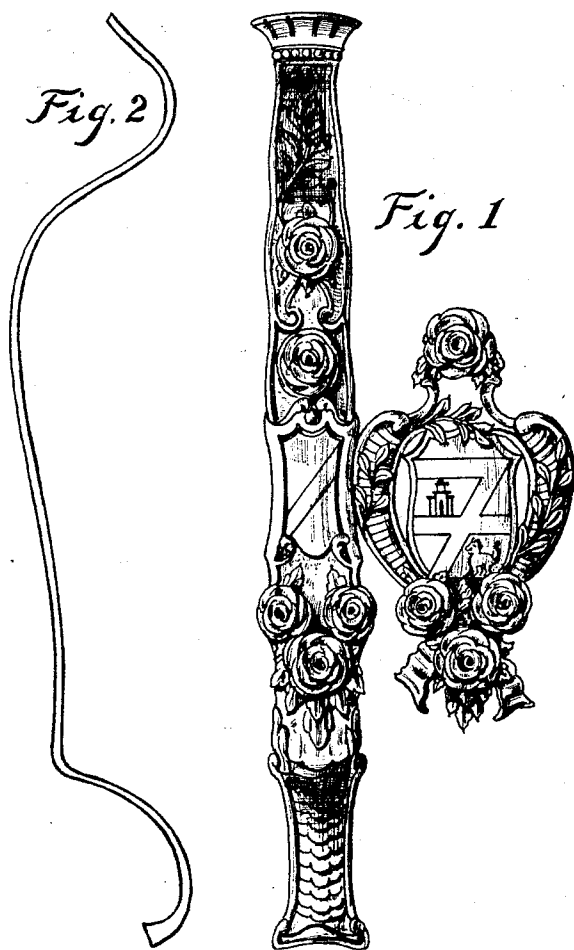

DESIGN FOR A COMBINED STRAP AND SHIELD FOR A LIGHTING FIXTURE.

To all whom it may concern:
