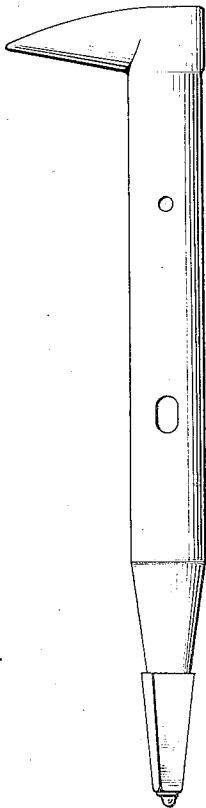

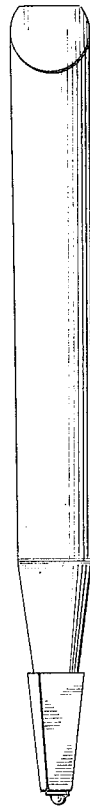

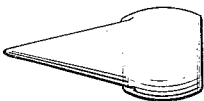
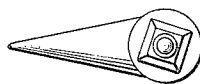

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Fred Semski, a citizen of the United States, and resident of Edgar, in the county of Marathon, in the State of Wisconsin, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination Tool, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
