

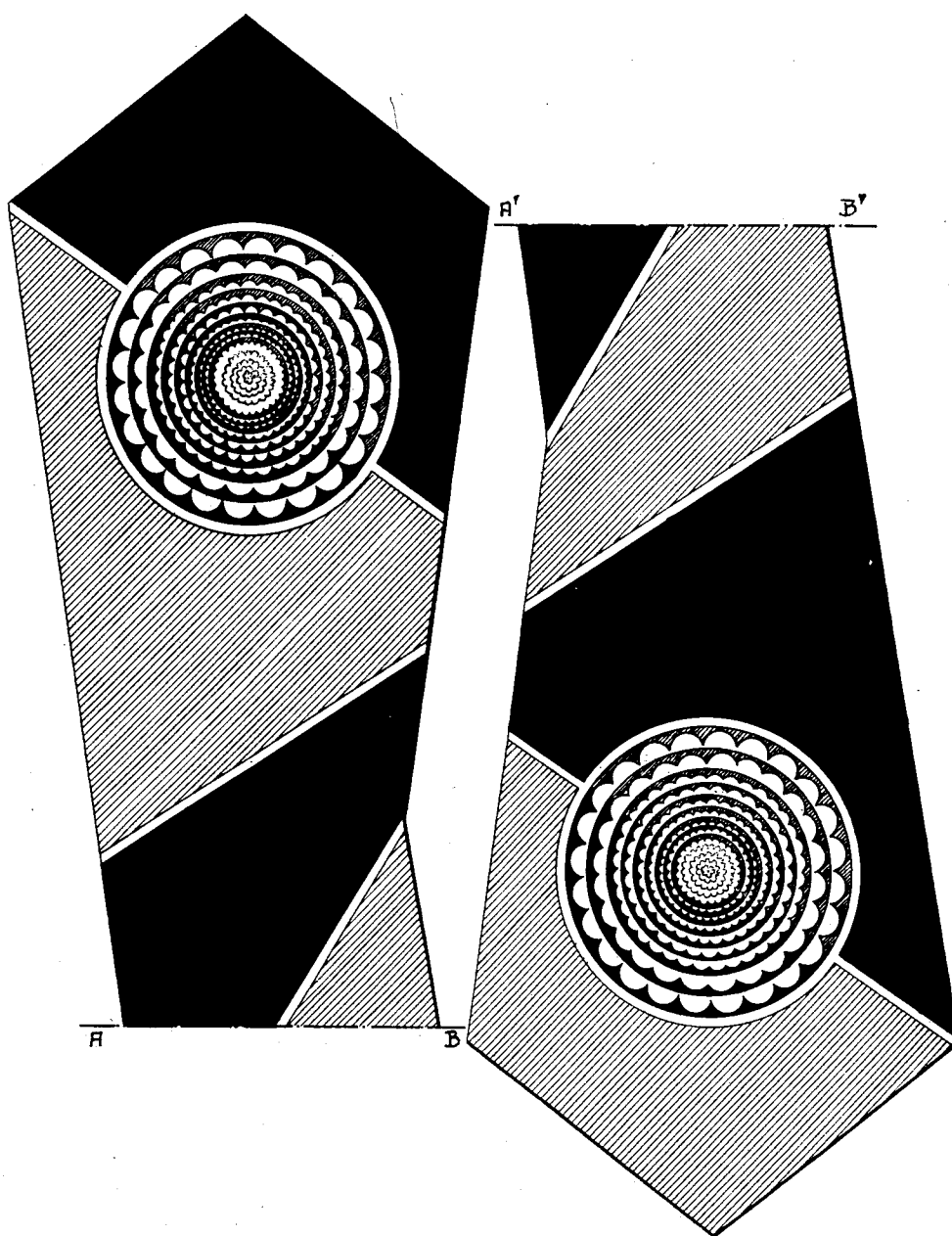

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC COLLAR OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed December 1, 1932. Serial No. 46,242. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM WILLHEIM, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 115 Central Park West, in the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric Collar or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric collar showing my new design. For conven-

ience of illustration and to show the design more in detail the same has been divided. The design is continuous. The dot and dash lines AB and A'B' respectively coincide and overlies each other. The drawing is lined to indicate shading.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric collar or similar article as shown and described.
