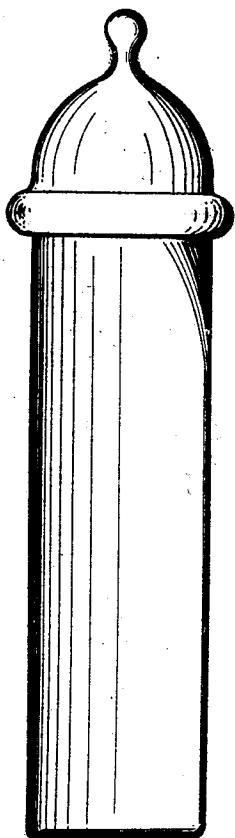

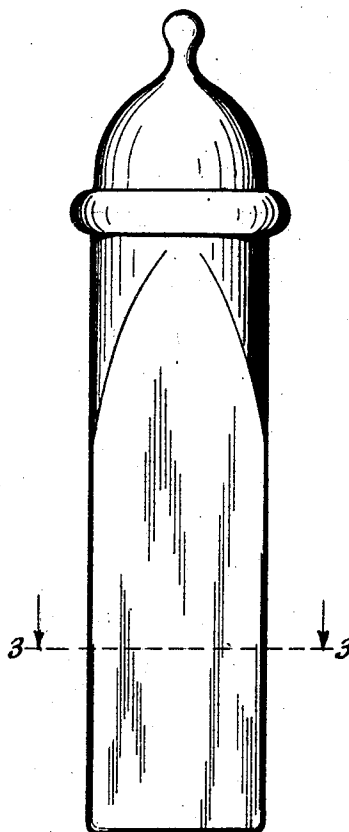
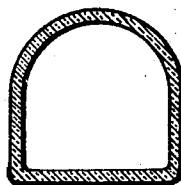

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARGARET E. PALMER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles, and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Nursing Bottles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
