





FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a mattress core embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged corner section of FIG. 1 showing the ornamental features thereof in greater detail; and FIG. 3 is a section on the line 3—3 of FIG. 2.

The illustrated design is characterized by rows of holes that extend around the peripheral zone of the mattress core, the holes of said rows each being surrounded by a convex-shaped collar.

We claim:
