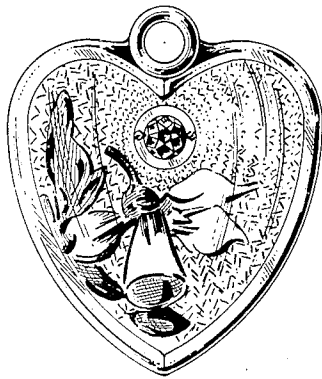

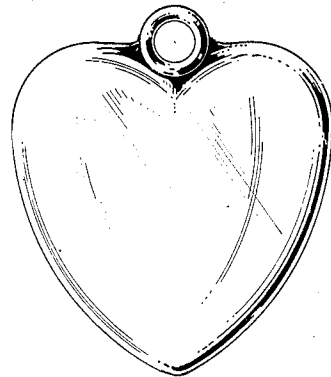

DESIGN FOR A CHARM OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Walter Lampl, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Charm or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a charm or similar article embodying my new design;

Figure 2 is a side edge elevation thereof; and

Figure 3 is a rear elevational view of the same.

The characteristic feature of the design is the specific flower design representing the month of January in combination with the birth stone corresponding therewith, arranged in a charm or similar article, specifically as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a charm or similar article, as shown and described.
