
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ceiling mounted communication access point, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a ceiling mounted communication access point showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof; and, FIG. 3 is another bottom perspective view thereof, shown on a reduced scale and in an alternate environment. The broken line showing of environment in the figure drawings is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.




