FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the dryer of FIG. 1;

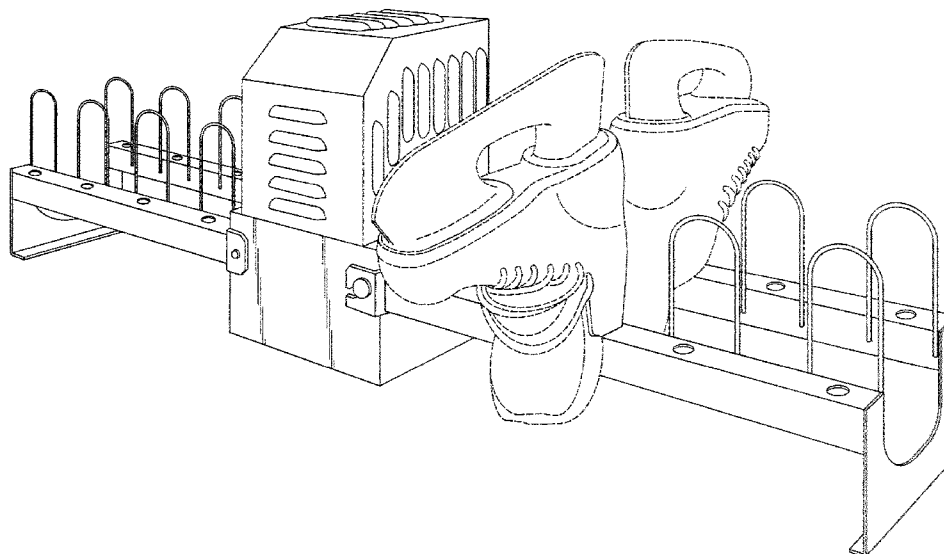
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the dryer of FIG. 1;

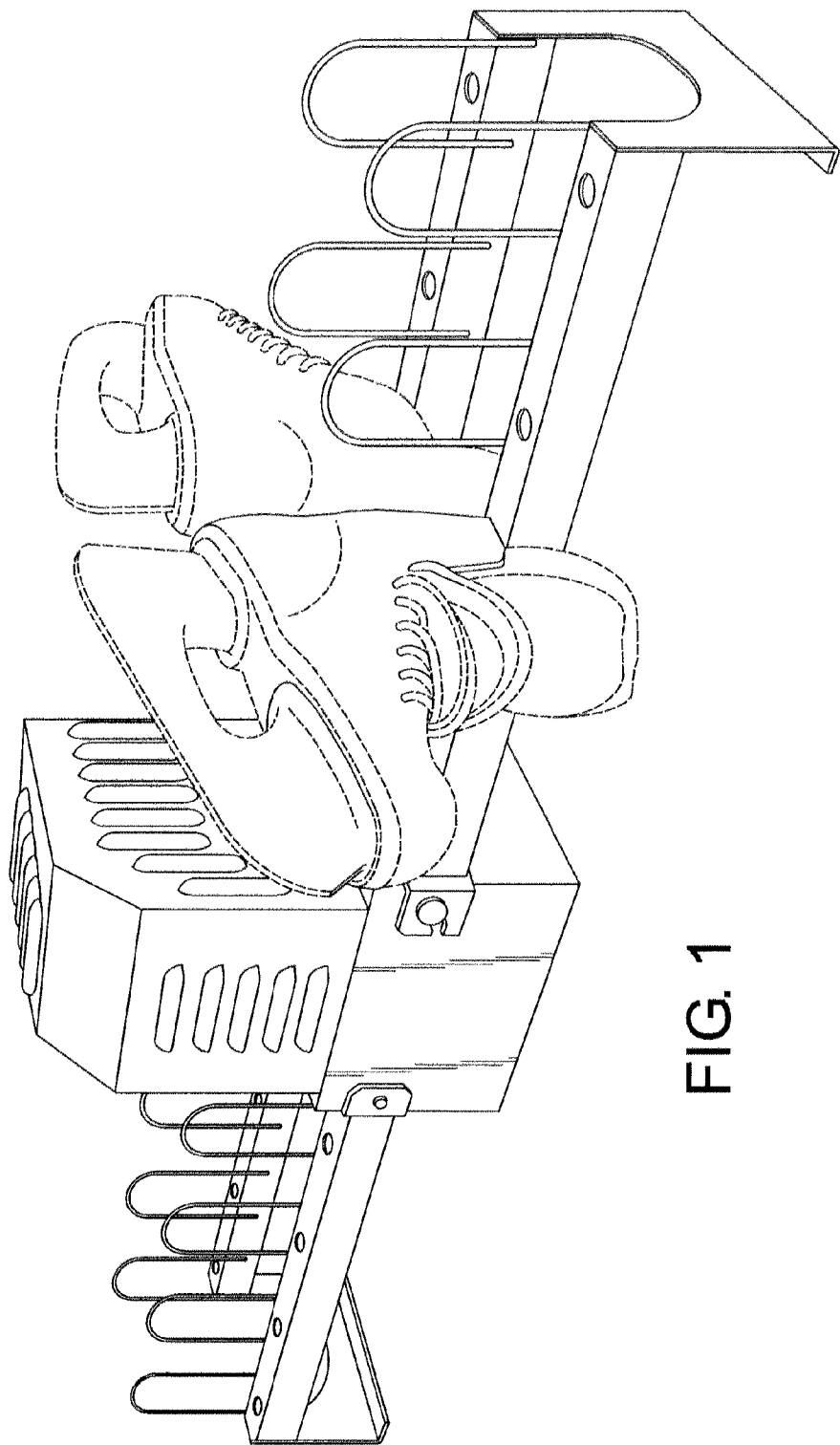

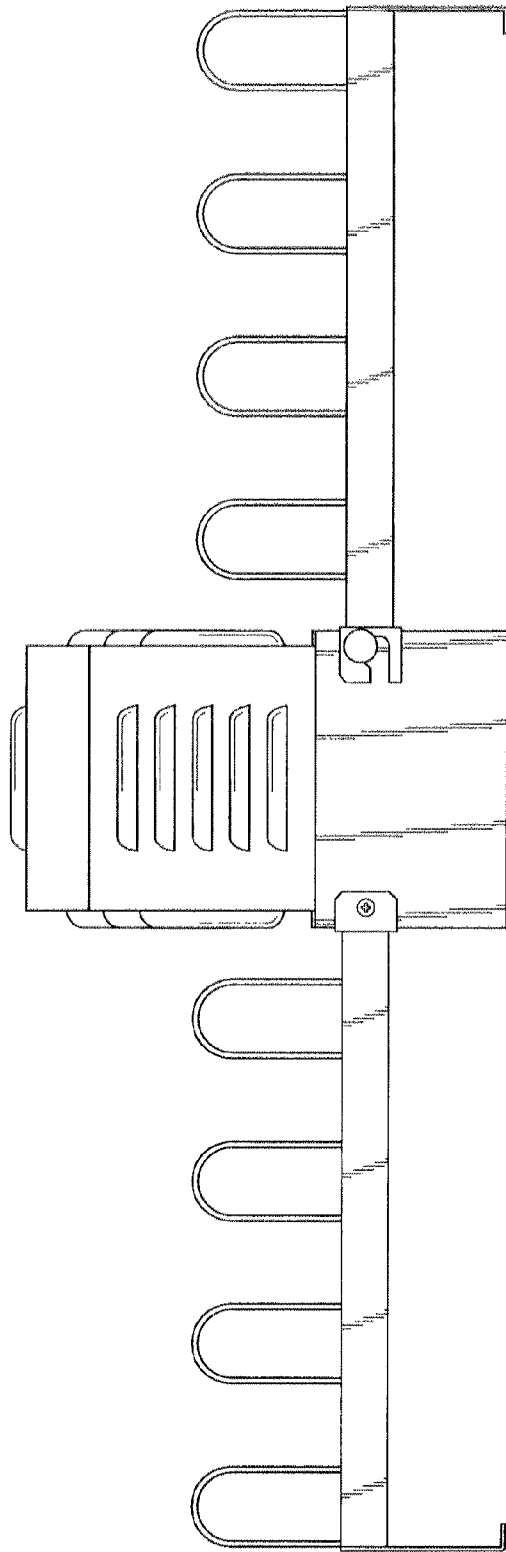

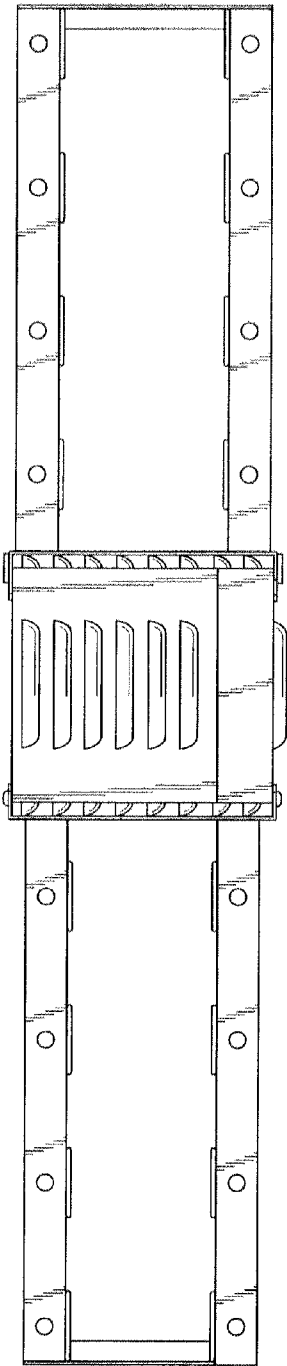

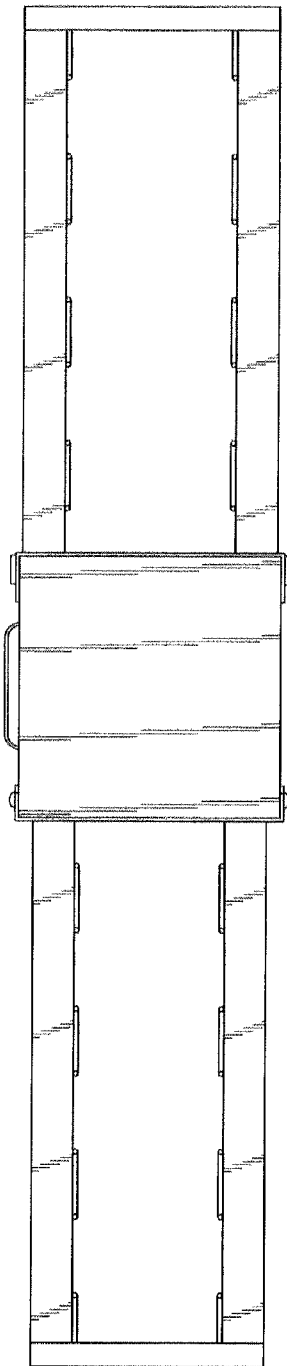

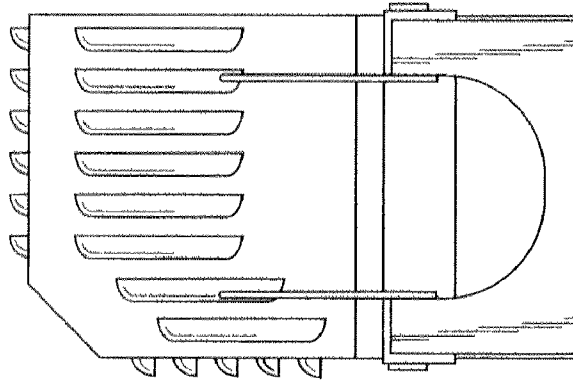

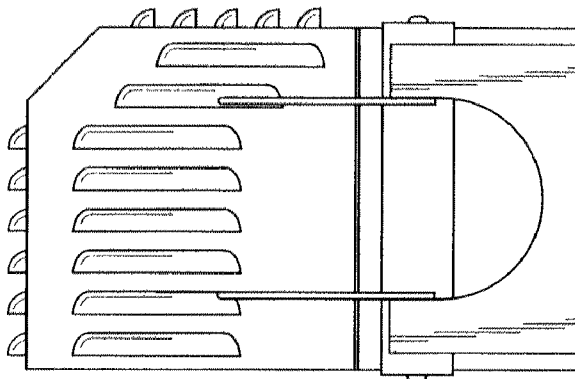

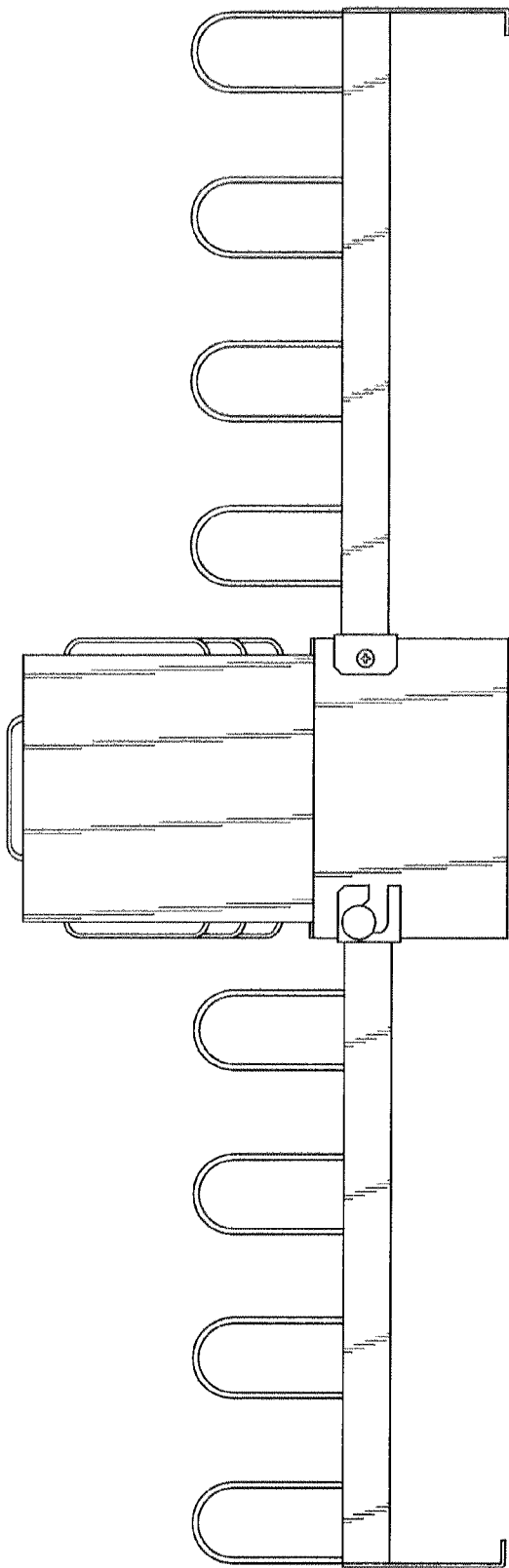
