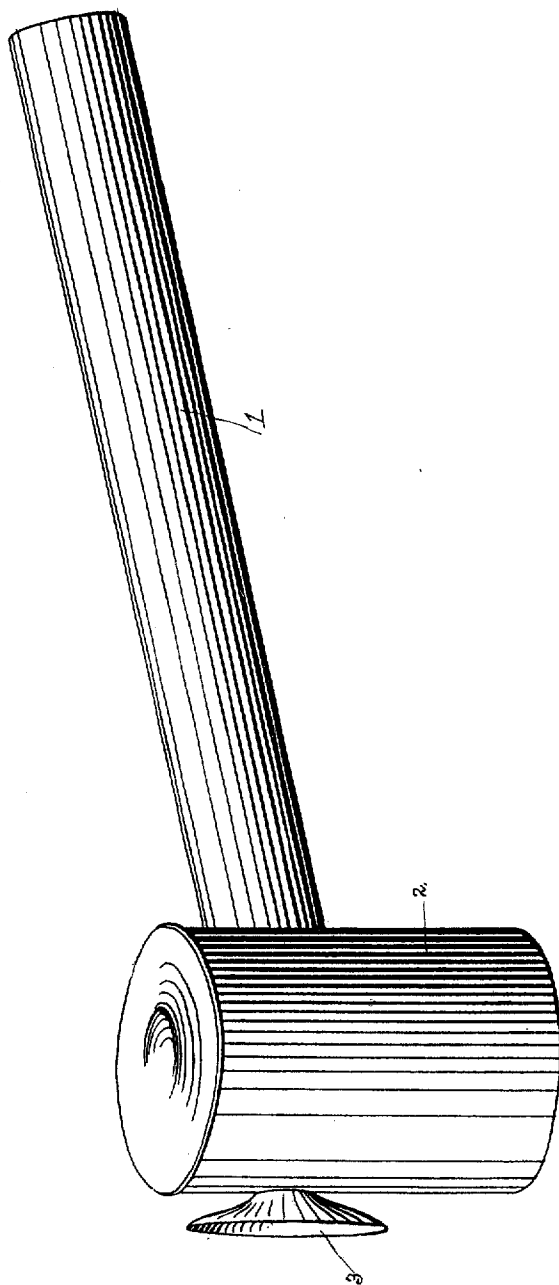

## DESIGN FOR A SPRAYER-BODY.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 28,211, dated January 25, 1898.

Application filed December 1, 1897. Serial No. 660,445. Term of patent 3½ years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CHARLES T. PRATT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Clayville, in the county of Oneida and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Sprayer-Body, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.  
The figure shows a perspective view of the sprayer-casing of my design.  
The novelty consists in the form and rela-

tive arrangement of the parts as shown in the drawing. The parts are the cylinder 1, the can 2, and the bell-nozzle 3, relatively arranged as shown.

What I claim is—

The design for a sprayer-body, substantially as shown and described.
