To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LOUIS M. MUSLINER, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of New York, borough of Manhattan, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Article of Manufacture, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of an article of manufacture, for instance, a sheet of leather, illustrating my new design.

It will be understood that the design is to be applied not only to a sheet of leather but to any other sheet or flat surface, as for instance, cloth, paper, sheet metal, wood and other materials capable of receiving the impression.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an article of manufacture, as shown and described.
