

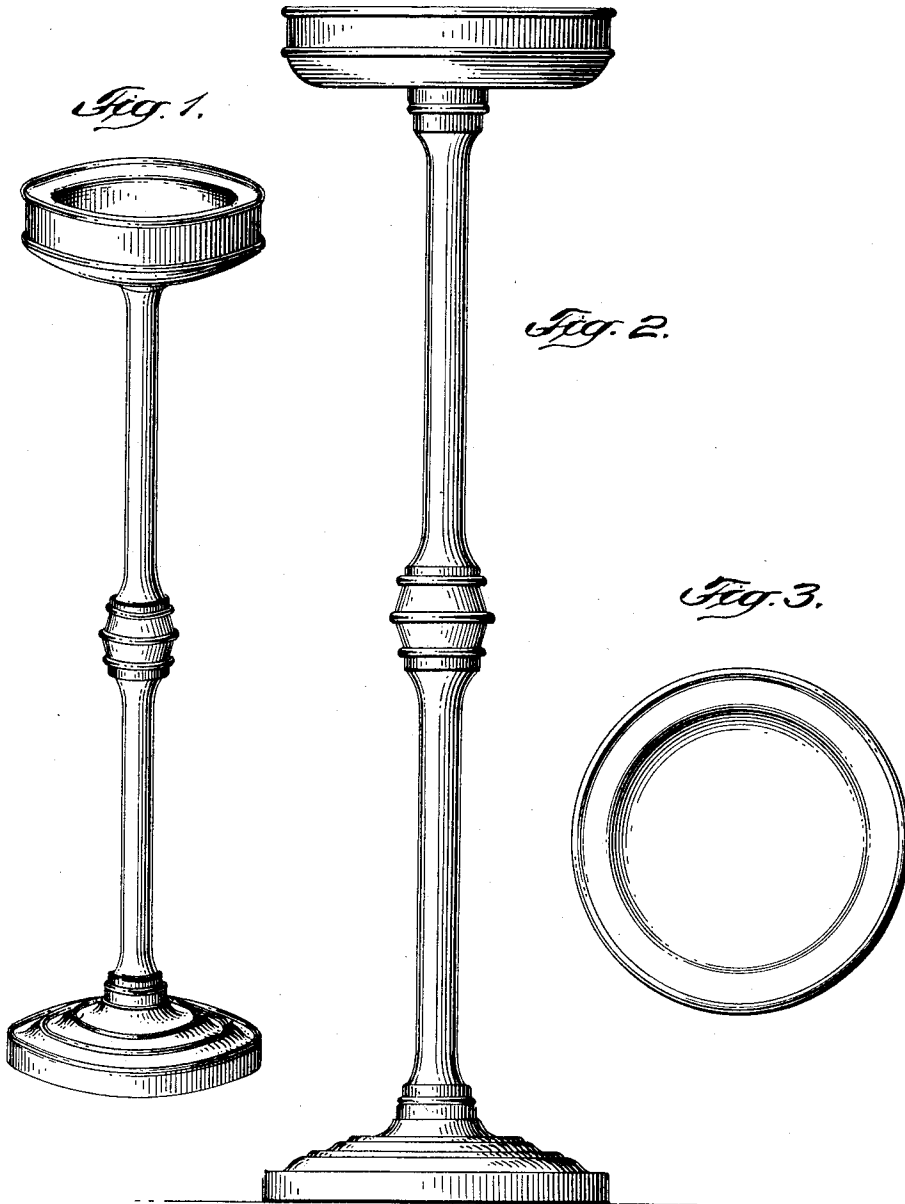

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN H. ASTRUCK, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Smokers' Stands, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a smoker's stand showing my new design; Fig. 2 a side view thereof, and Fig. 3 a plan.
