





To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Paul Fantel, a citizen of the United States, residing in Asbury Park, New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is an elevational view of a bottle showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a bottom plan view; and
