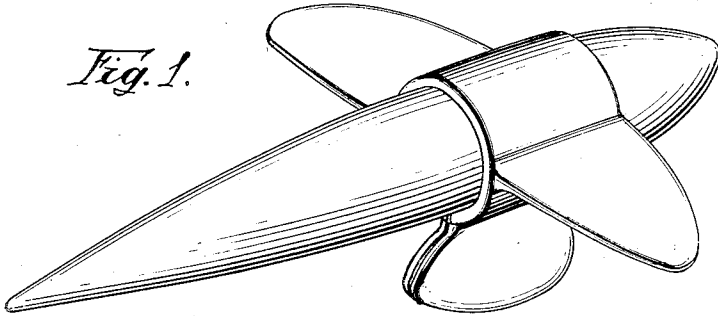

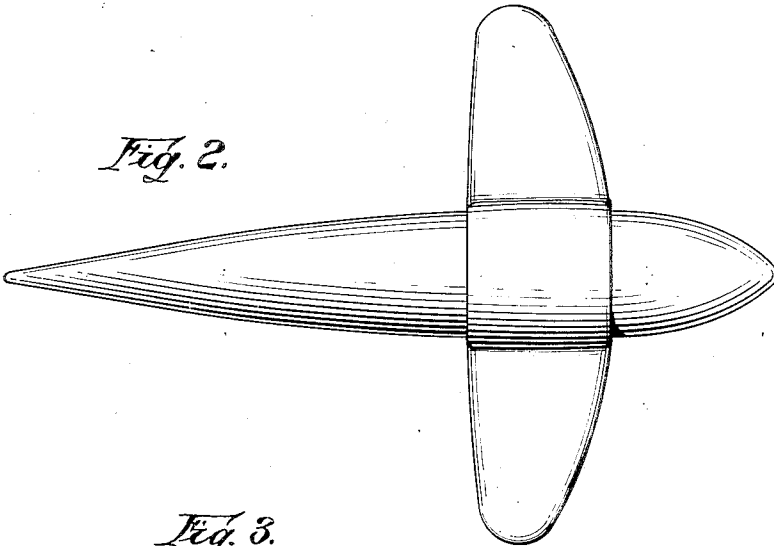

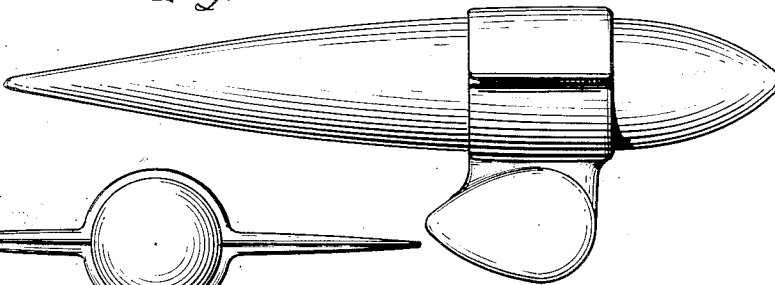
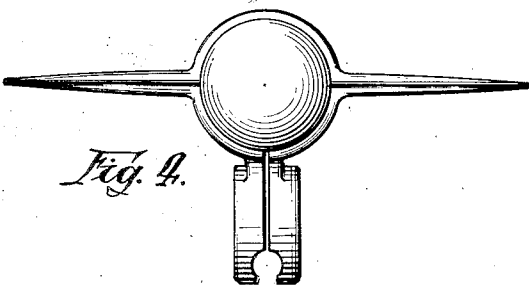

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Albert Sebek, a citizen of the United States, residing at 2303 South 62nd Avenue, Cicero, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Automobile Radiator Cap Ornament, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
