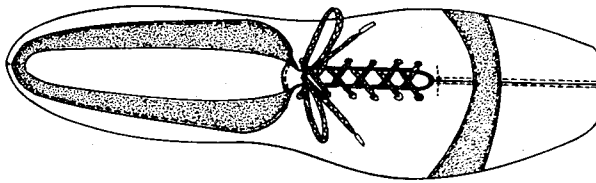

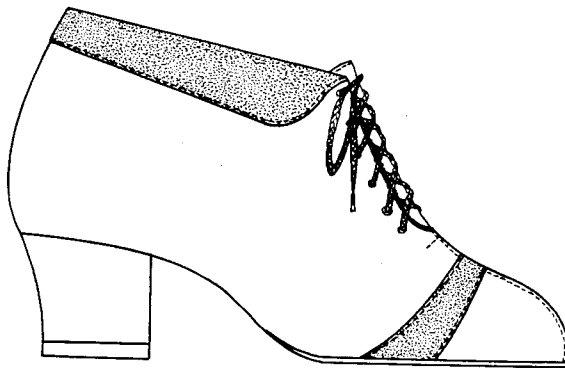

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Cohen, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Borough of Brooklyn, city of New York, county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
