DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the front, left, and top sides of an image sensor showing our new design;

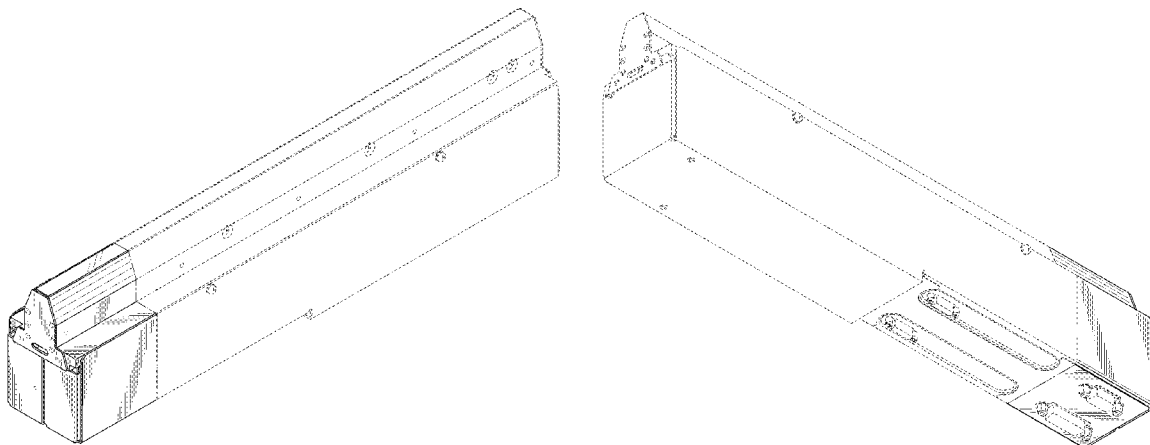

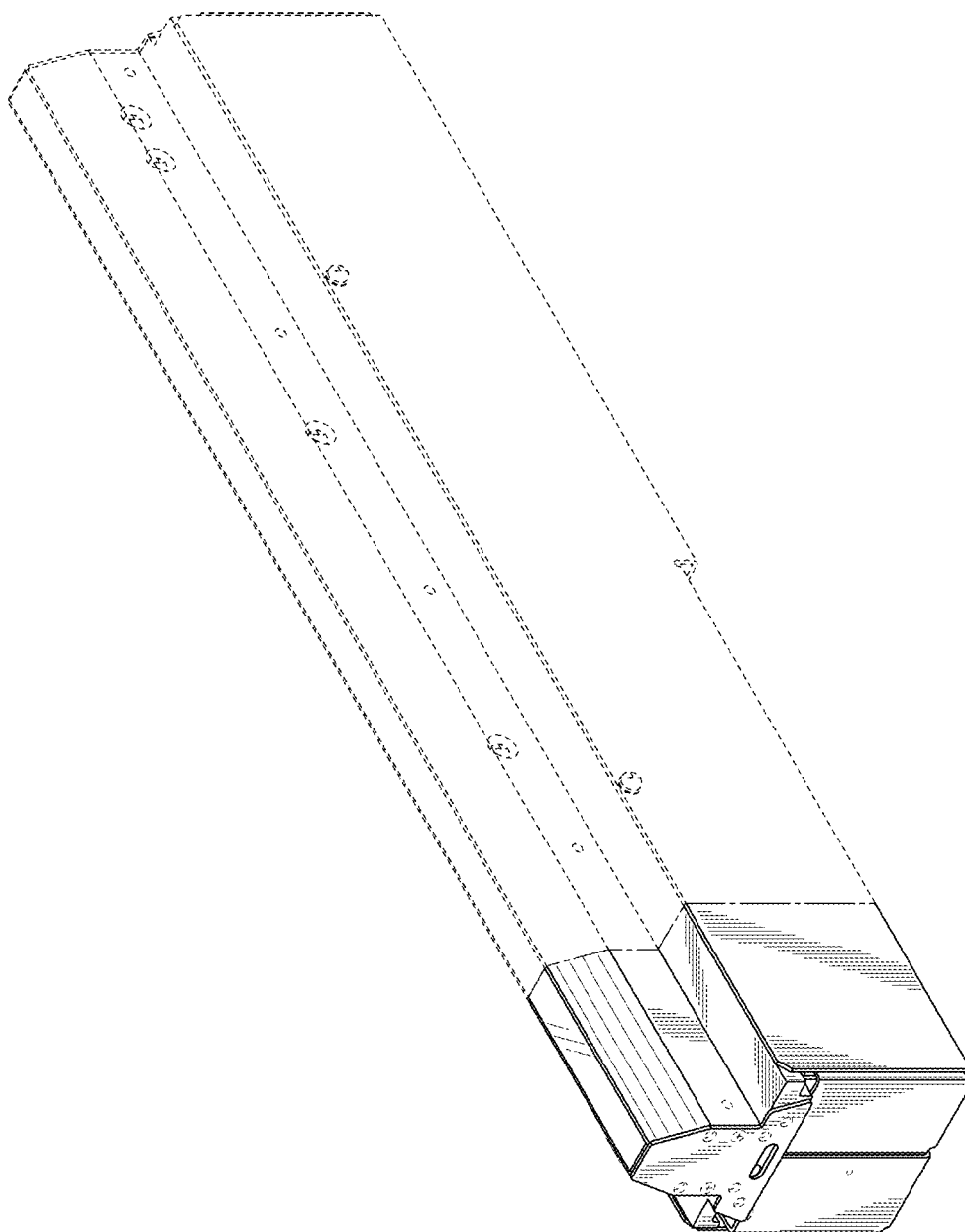

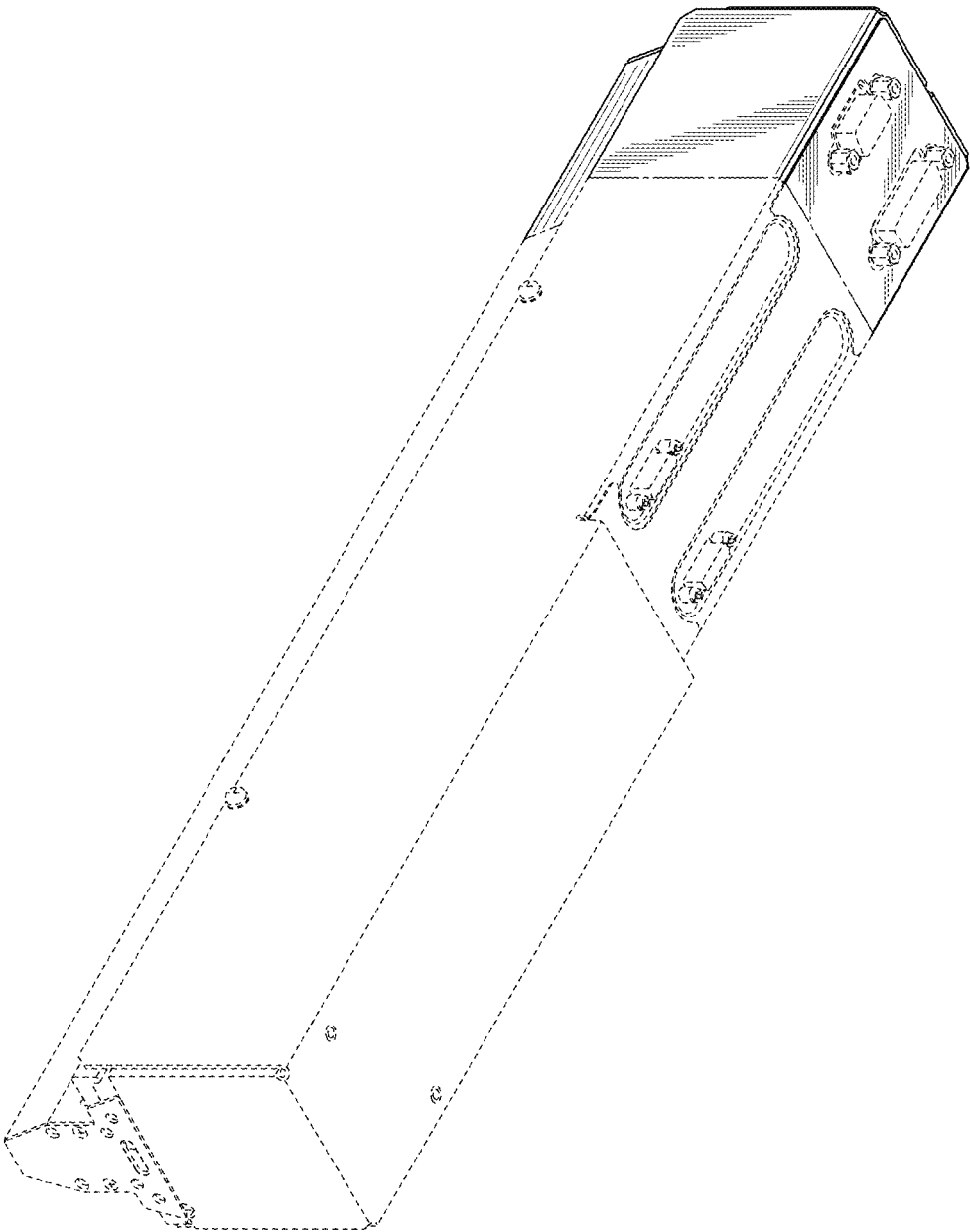

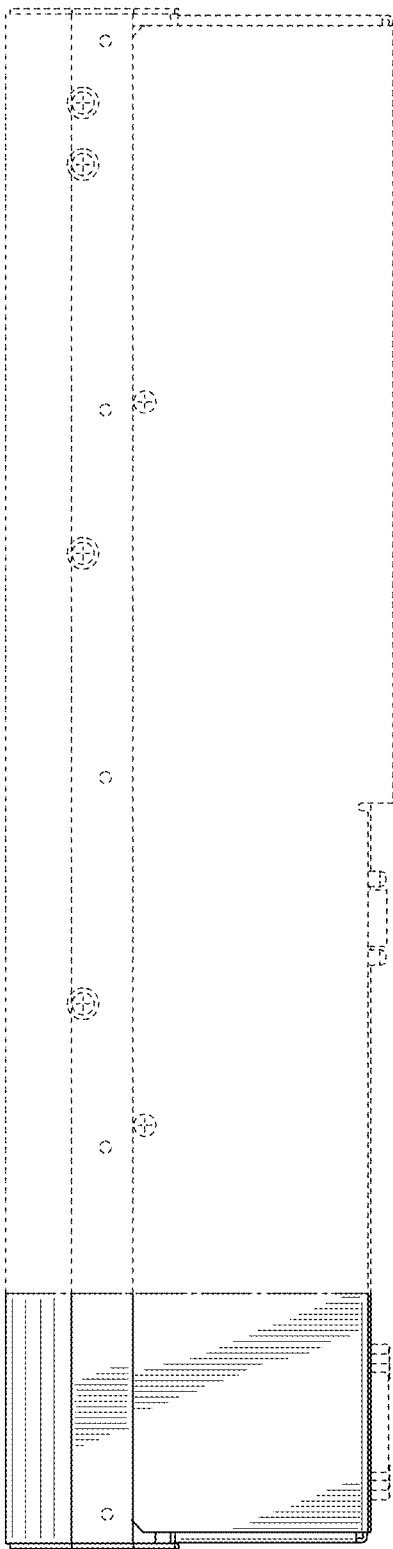

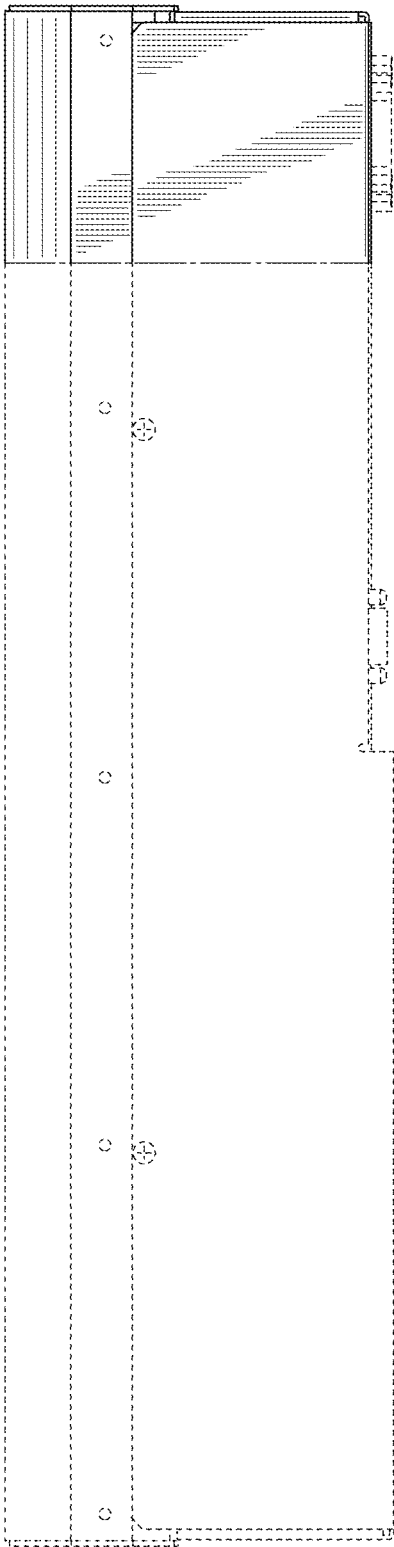

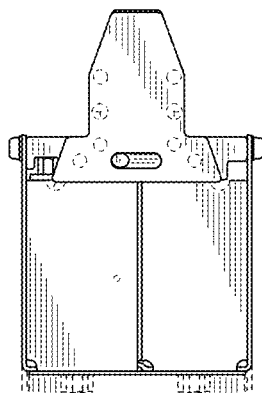

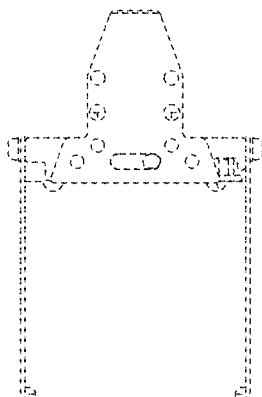

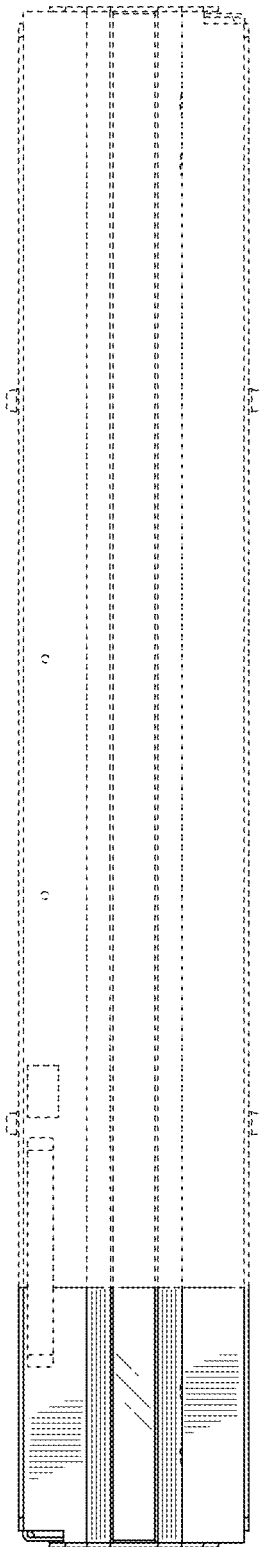
