FIG. 4 is a left plan view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1;

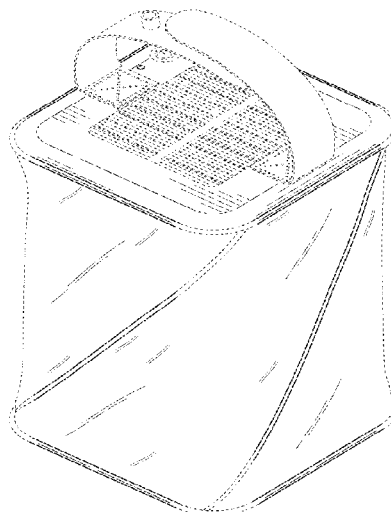
FIG. 5 is a right plan view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1;

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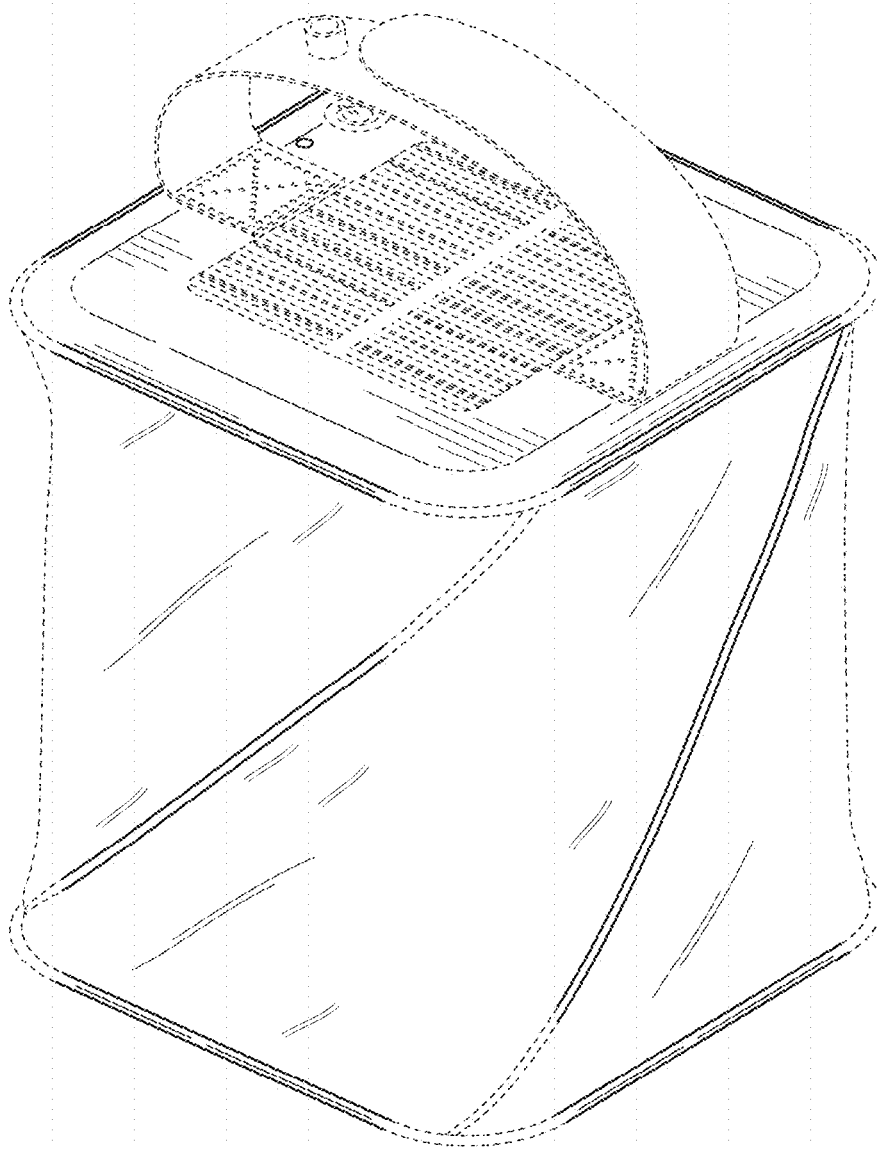

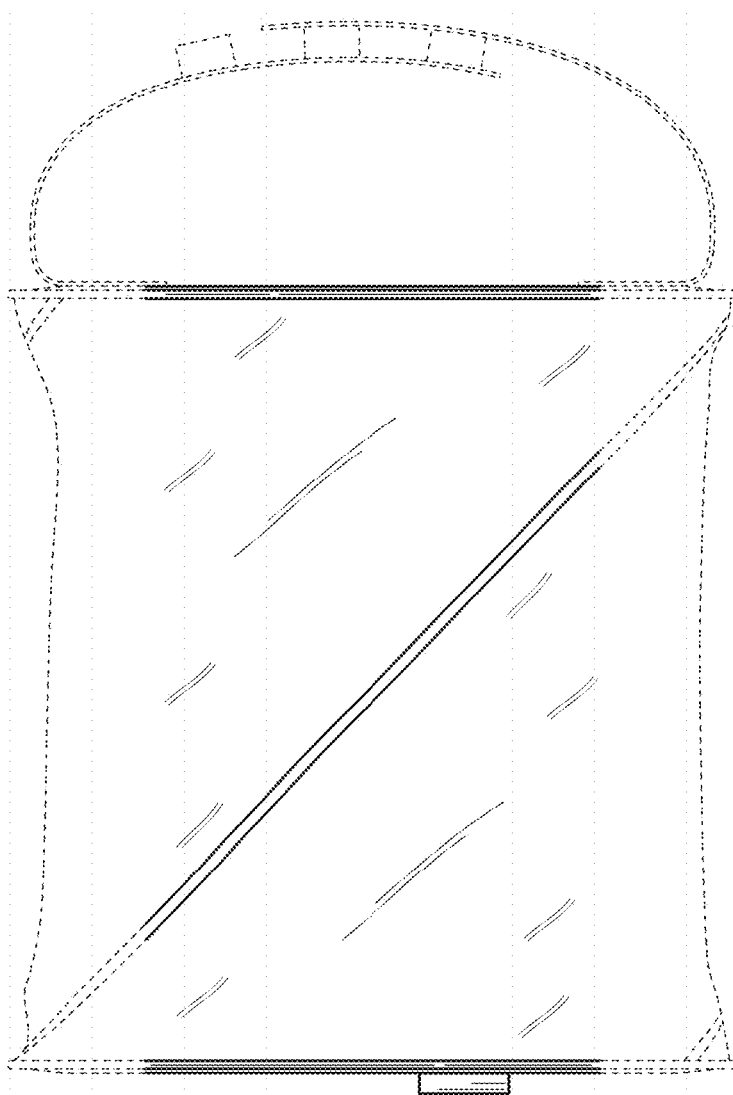

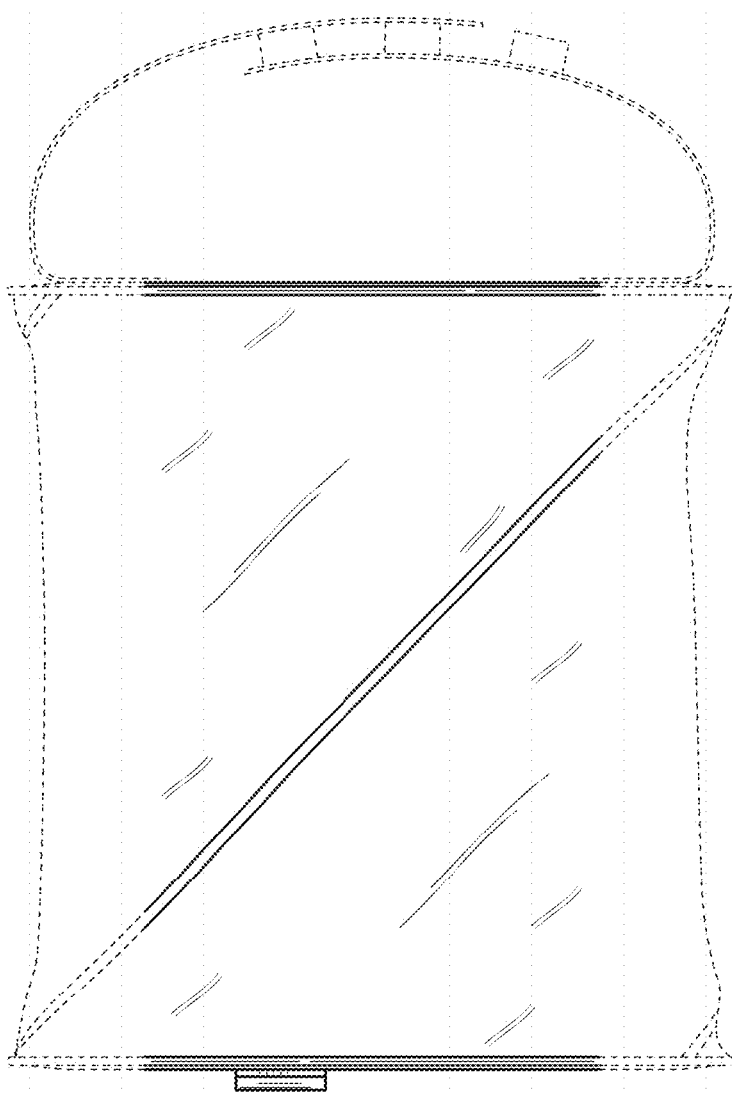

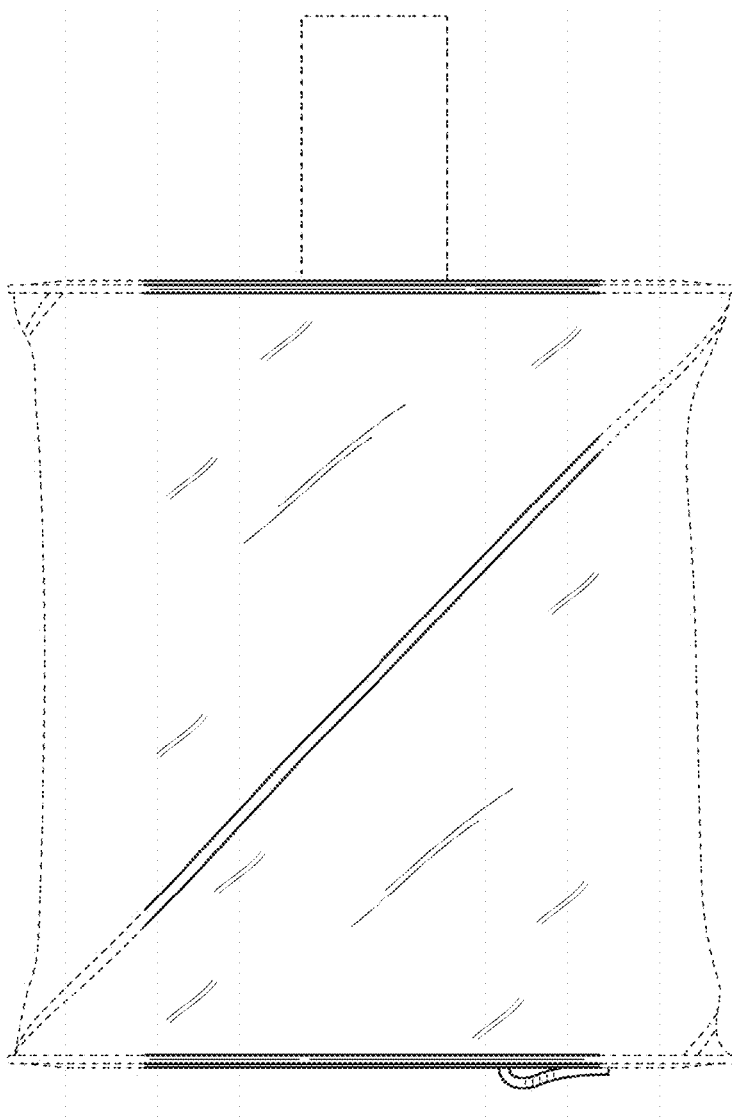

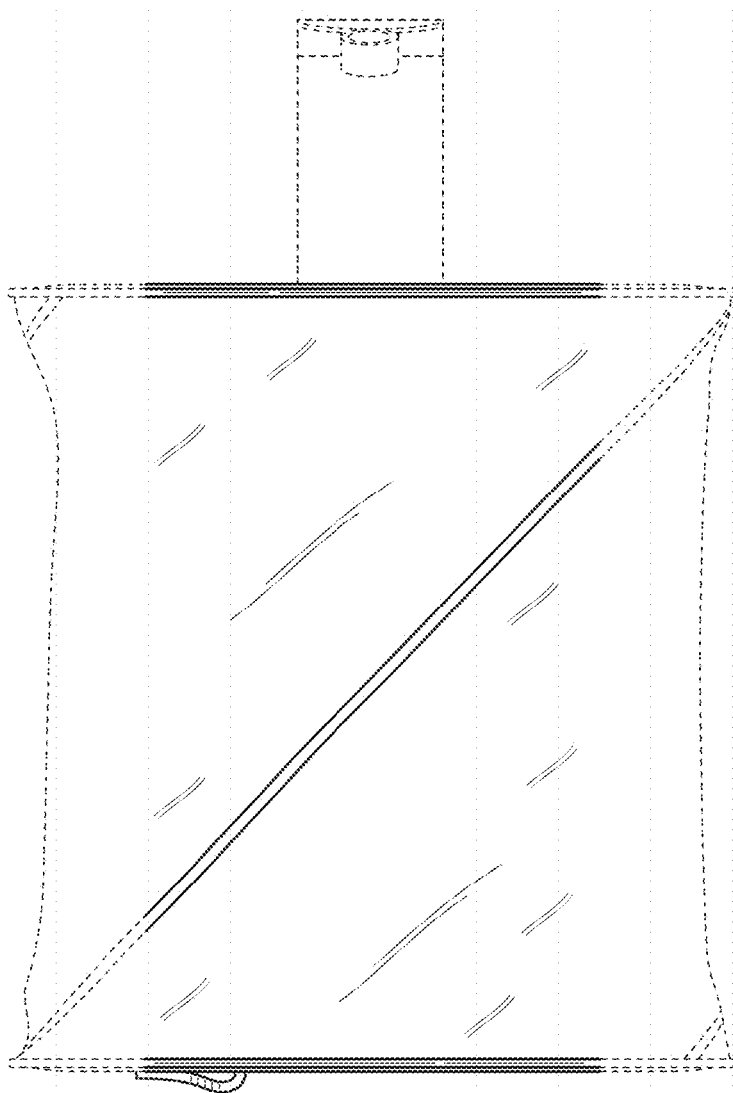

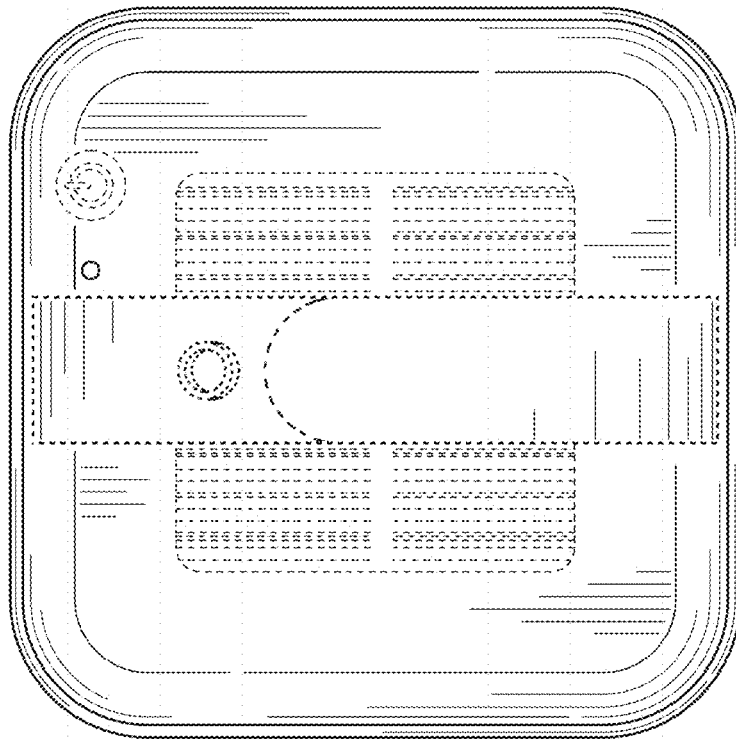

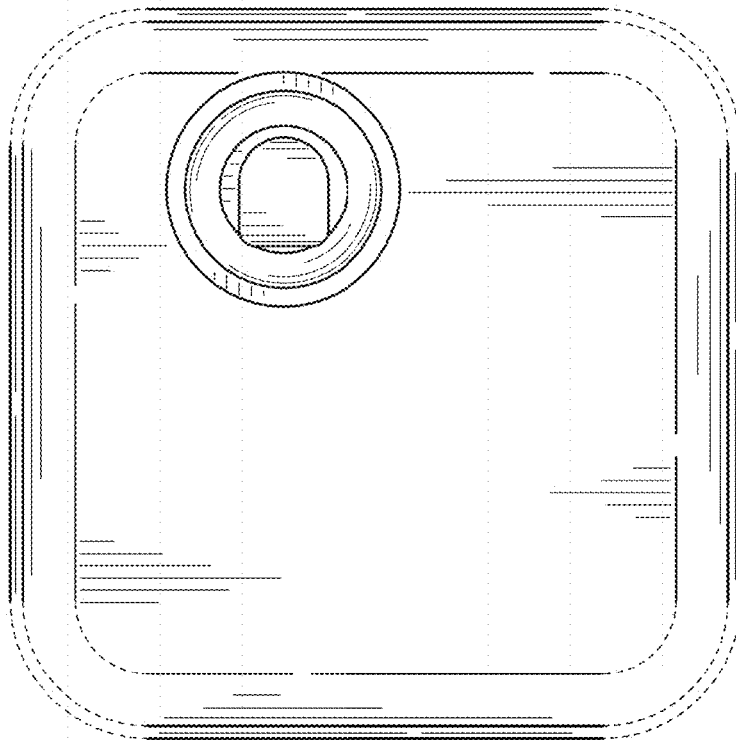

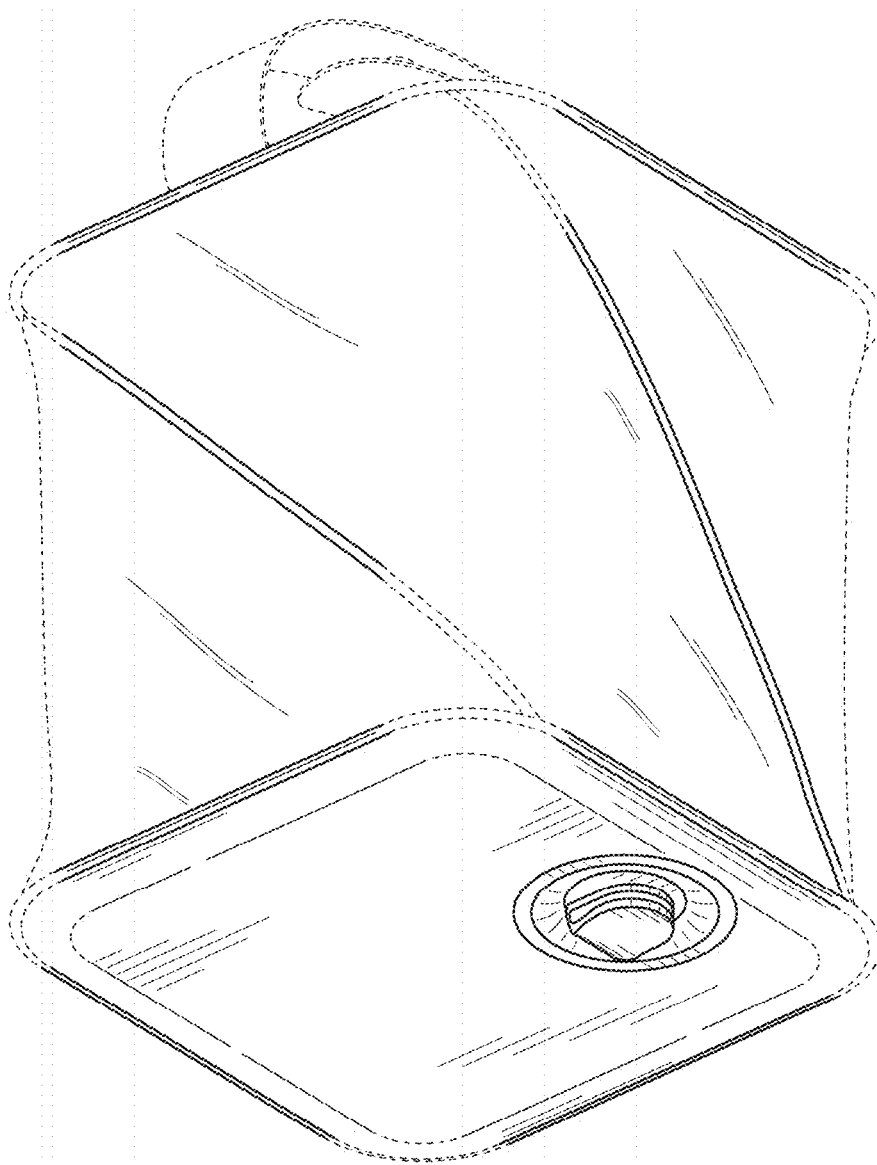
