

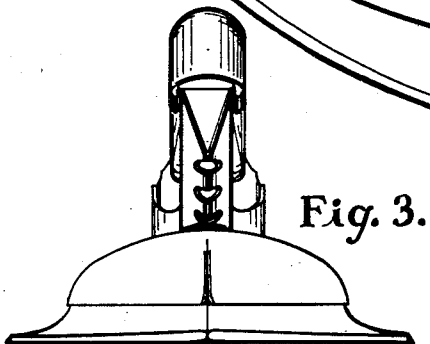
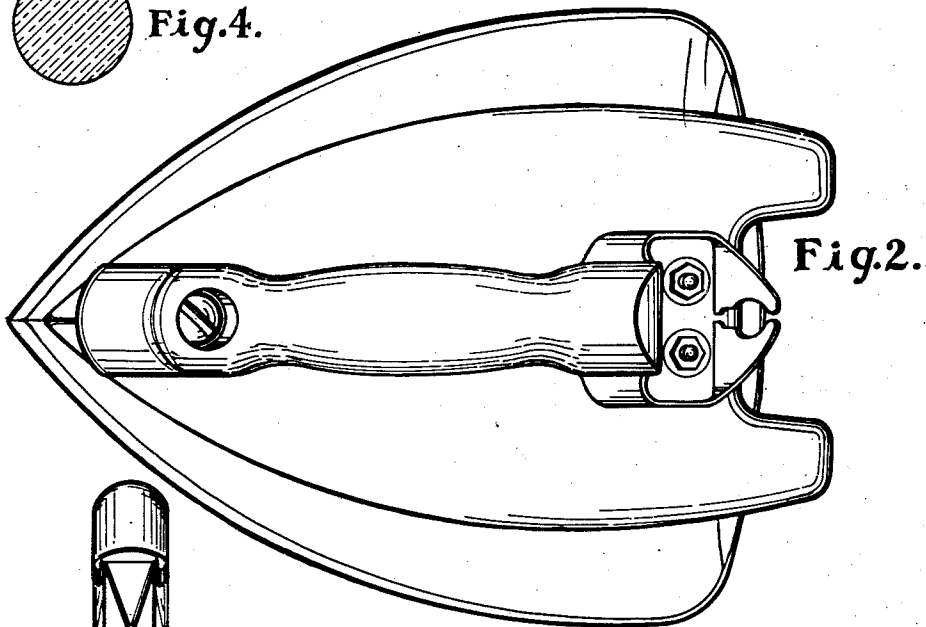
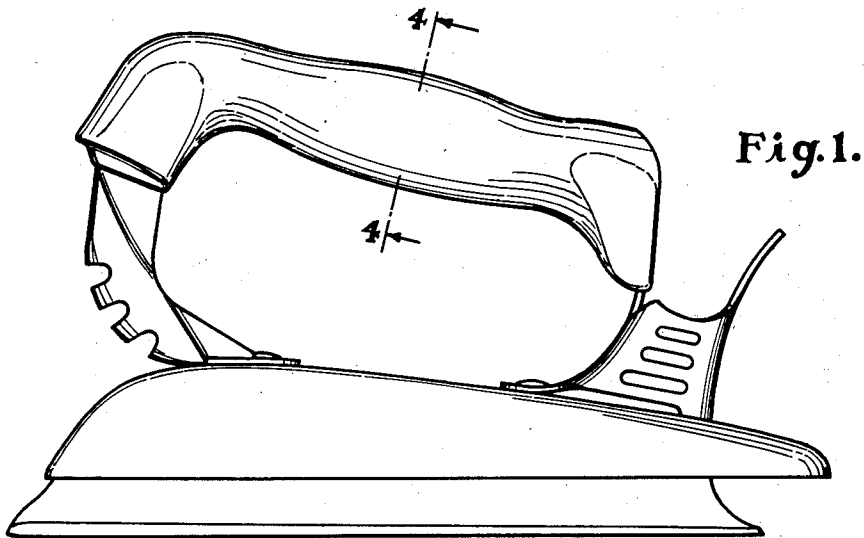

DESIGN FOR A SADIRON OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert B. Paysee, a citizen of the United States, residing at Oak Park, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Sadiron or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a sadiron or similar article, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the same.

Fig. 3 is a slightly reduced end view, looking from the toe end thereof.

Fig. 4 is a sectional view taken on line 4—4 of Fig. 1.
