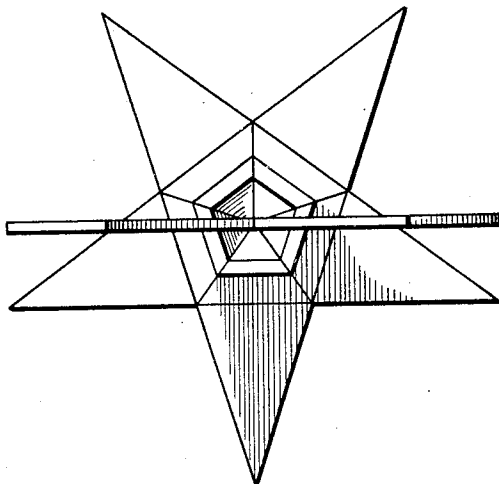

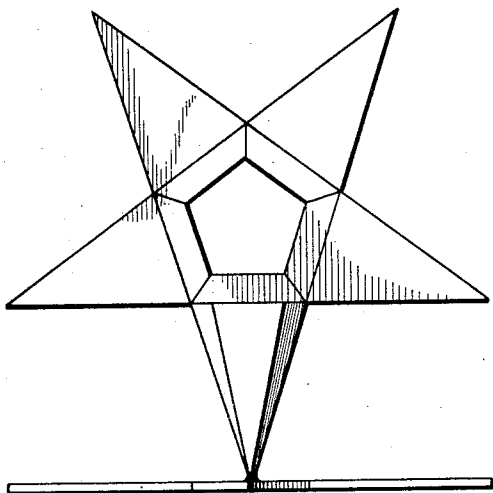
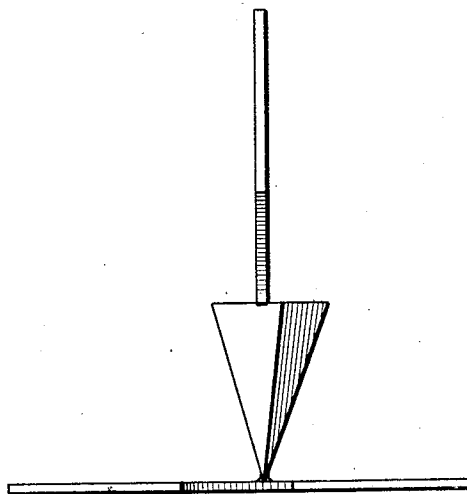

DESIGN FOR A VASE

Application filed January 12, 1931. Serial No. 38,283. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN WITTGREN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vase, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
