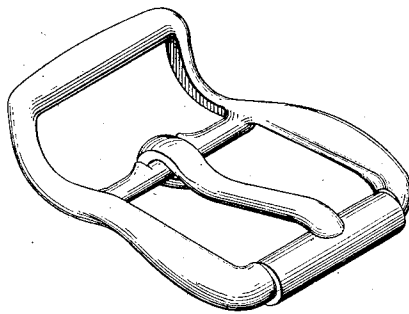

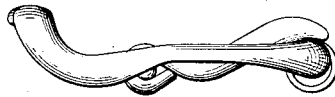
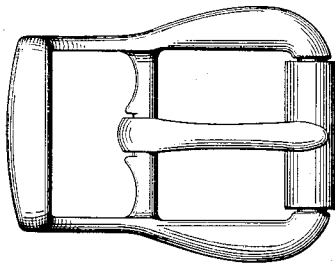

Be it known that I, WILLIAM A. SCHLEICHER, a resident of Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Buckle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—
