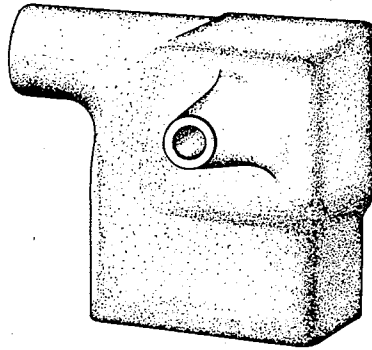

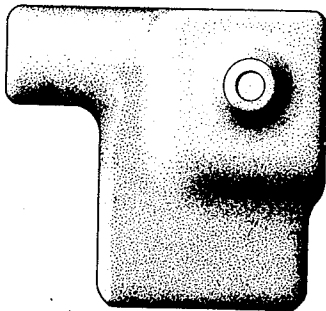

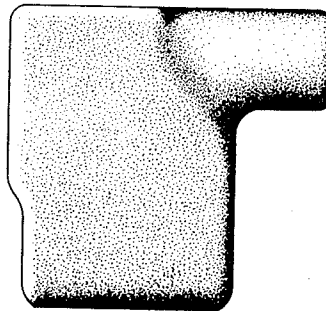

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William A. Hillenbrand, a citizen of the United States and resident of Batesville, in the county of Ripley and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bracket for an Over-Bed Table, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a bracket

for an over-bed table, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a front elevational view of the bracket.

Figure 3 is a rear elevational view; and

Figure 4 is an end elevational view thereof.
