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
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(54) Title: METHOD AND SYSTEM FOR AUTOMATED PAYMENT AUTHORIZATION AND SETTLEMENT



(57) Abstract: The present invention provides a system and method to enable a third party service provider of EIPP services (120a) to initiate authorization and settlement of payment card payments with invoice line item data (Level III data), on behalf of either Buyer/Payers (110) or Supplier/Payees (130) to credit card acquirers (160) and/or transaction processors (160). Payment initiation (550) is based on submission of either a pre-approved invoice or order confirmation validated against a purchase order, or an invoice approved by the Buyer/Payer organization (110) and scheduled for payment (665).
