

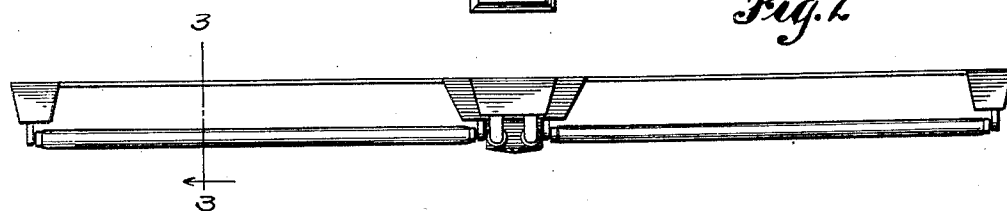
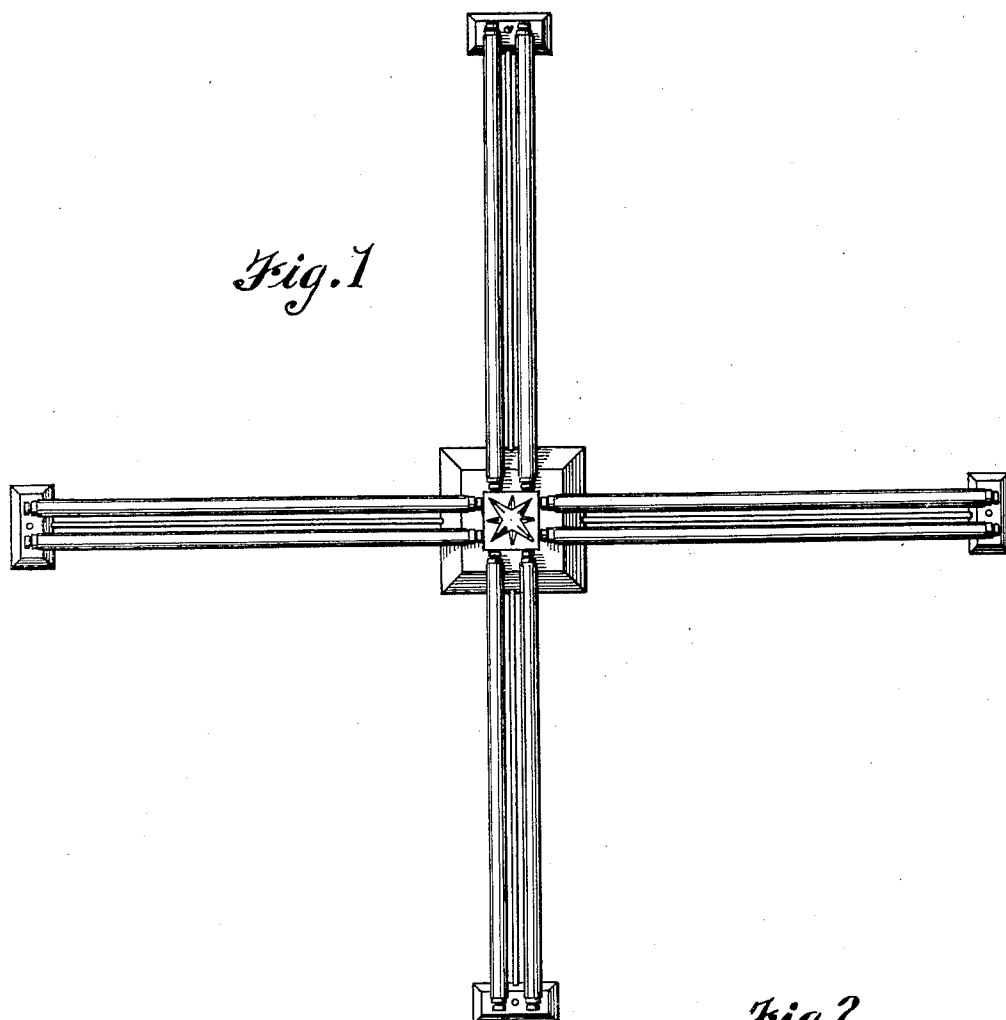

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING FIXTURE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Wilfrid Paul Heath, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Richmond Beach, King County, Washington, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lighting Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein—

Fig. 1 is a bottom plan view of a lighting fixture embodying my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

Fig. 3 is a cross sectional view on line 3—3 in Fig. 2.
