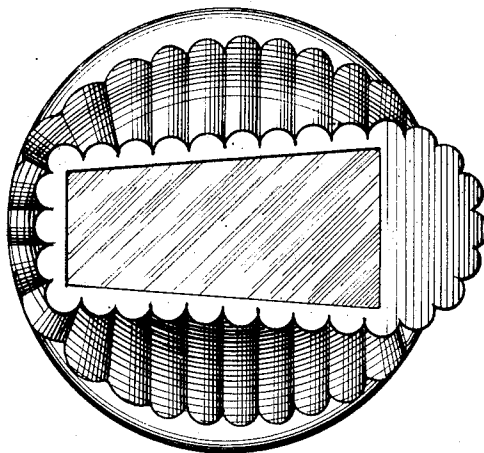
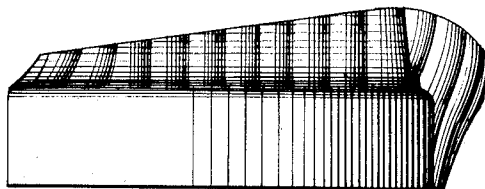

DESIGN FOR A RADIATOR CAP

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDELLARD L. GILBERT, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Fort Bayard, in the county of Grant and State of New Mexico, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Radiator Cap, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
