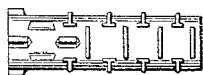
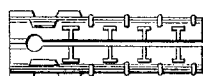

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY W. PLEISTER, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Westfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Anchor or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of my anchor illustrating my new design; Fig. 2 is a side elevation of my anchor.
