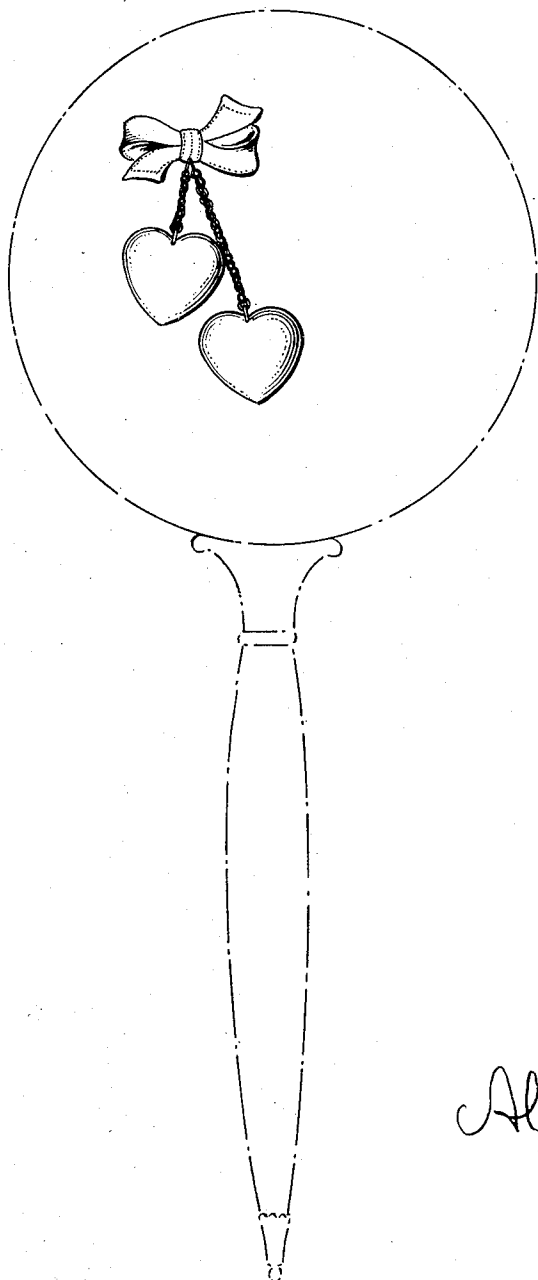

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Alfred F. Reilly, a citizen of the United States, residing at North Attleboro, county of Bristol and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Hand Mirror Frame or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the accompanying drawing,

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a hand mirror frame showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the head portion of the frame shown in Fig. 1.

The side not shown of the article illustrated is substantially plain.

The dominant feature of my invention resides in the ornamentation on the head piece of the hand mirror frame shown in full lines in the drawing.

I claim as my invention:

The ornamental design for a hand mirror frame or the like, as shown and described.
