The ornamental design for an end closure for a container, substantially as shown.

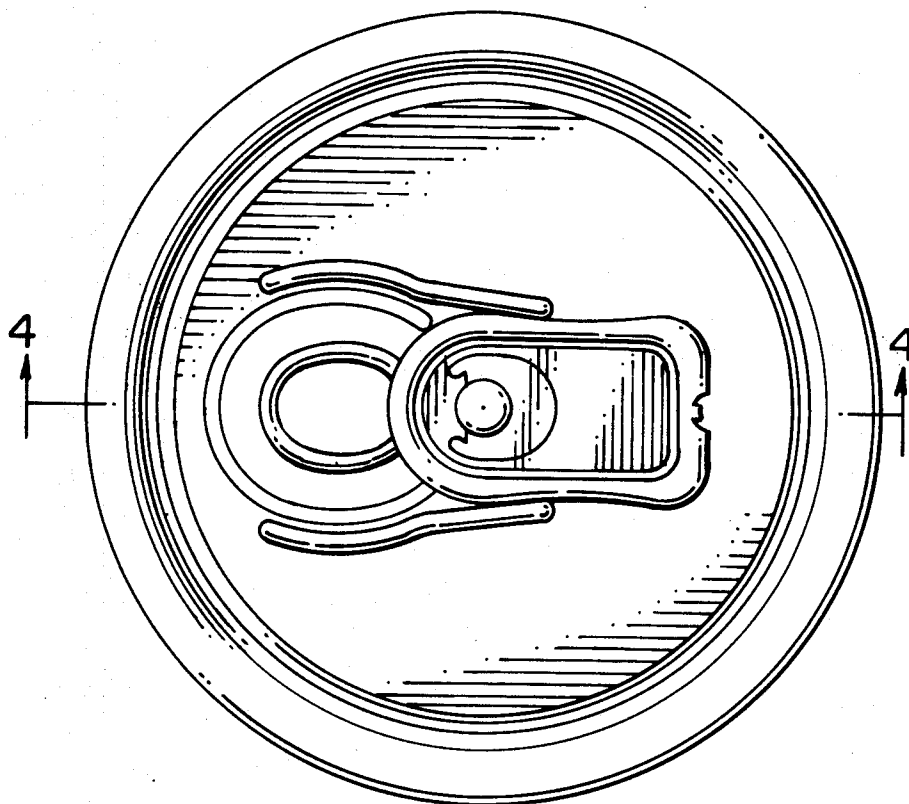
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on the line 4—4 of FIG. 2.



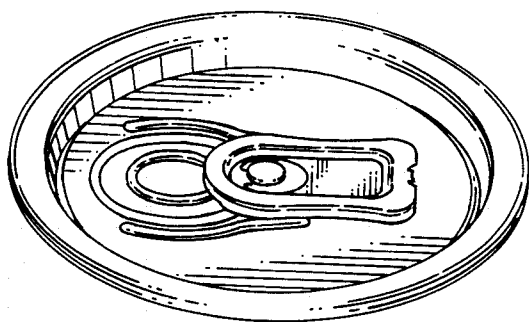

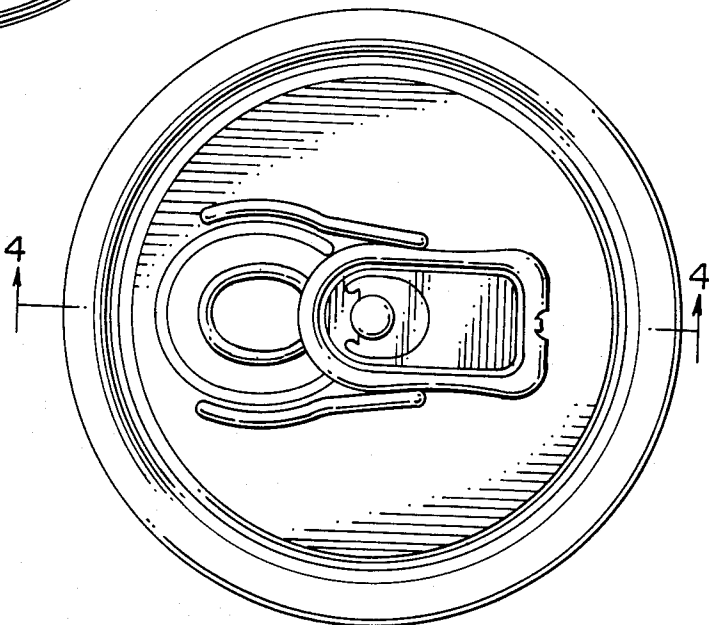

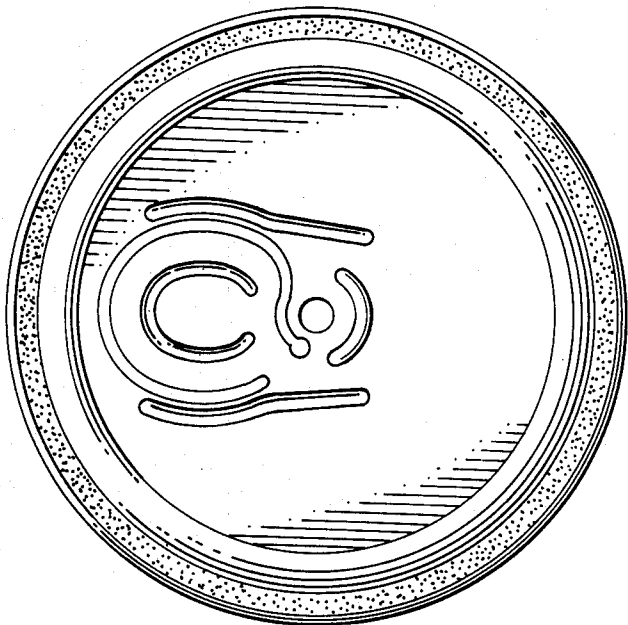

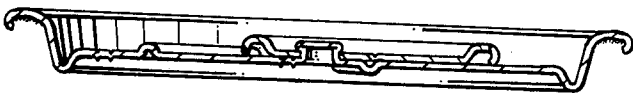
