

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George E. Nerney, a citizen of the United States, residing in the town of Attleboro, in the county of Bristol and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Handles for Pierced Spoons, Forks, or Similar Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of the observe side

of a spoon illustrating my design. Fig. 2 is an enlarged detail perspective view of the end of the handle thereof.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a handle for a pierced spoon, fork or similar article, as shown.
