FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

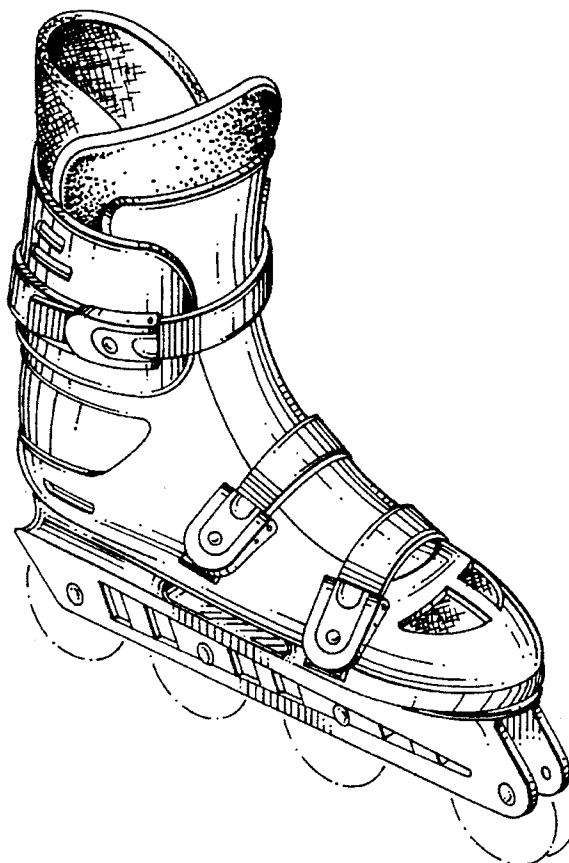
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

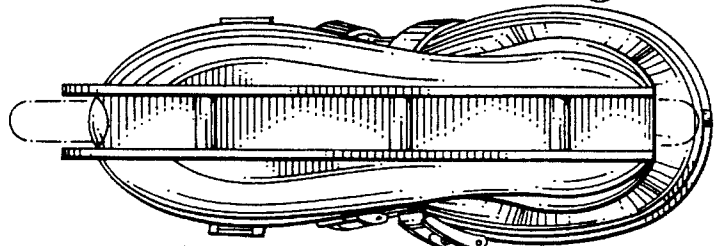
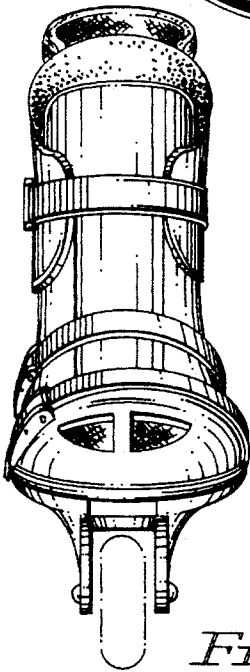
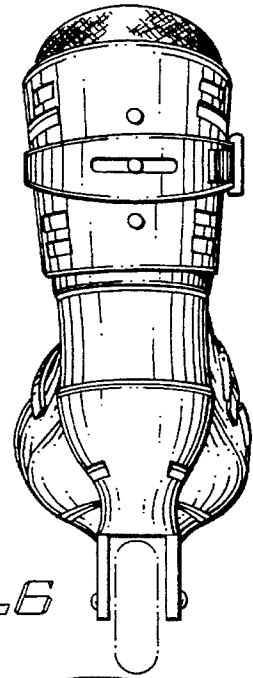
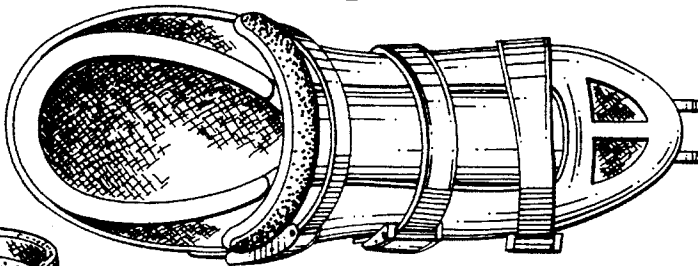
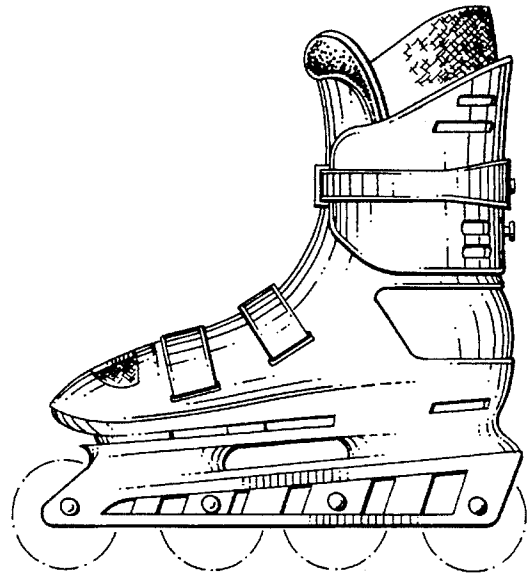
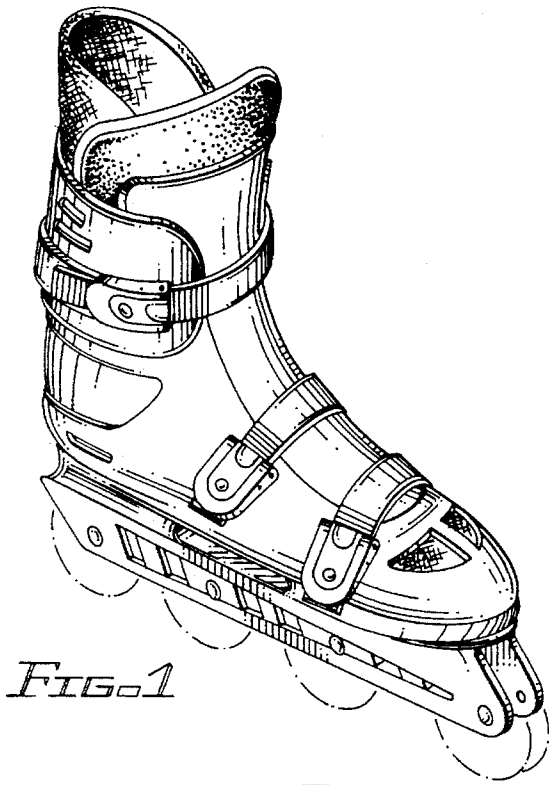
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
