

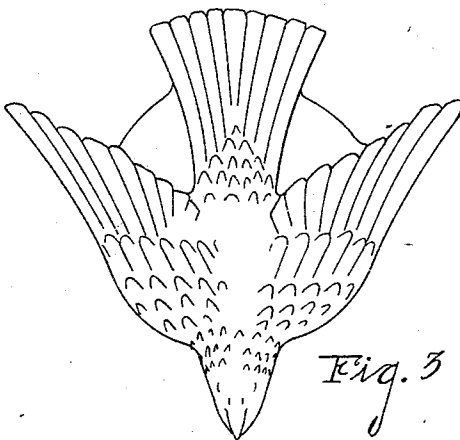
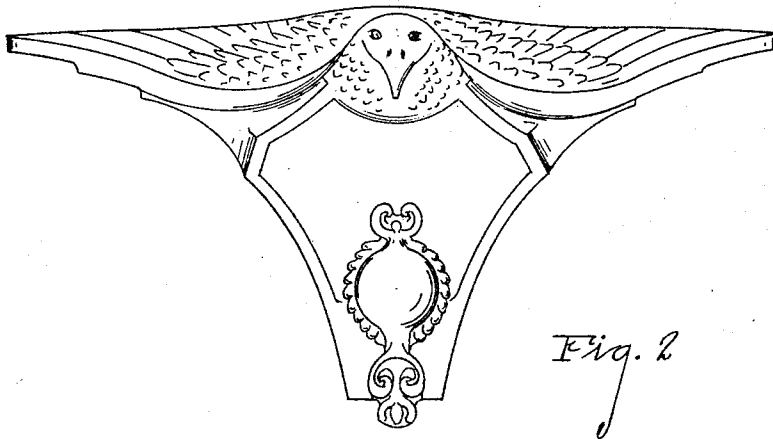
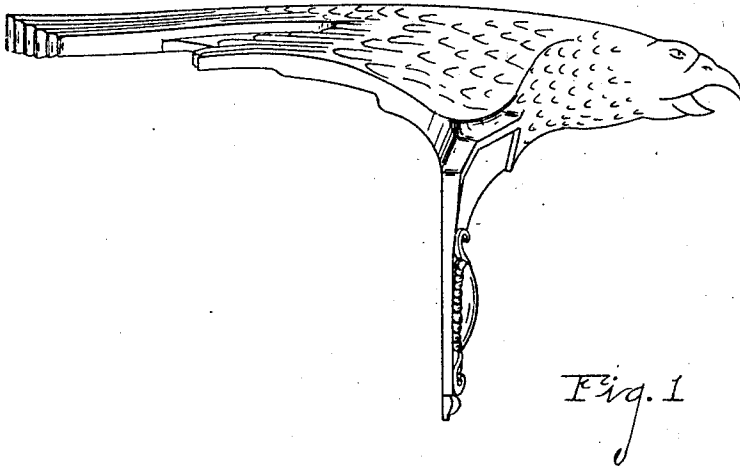

DESIGN FOR A RADIATOR ORNAMENT.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FREDERICK C.
