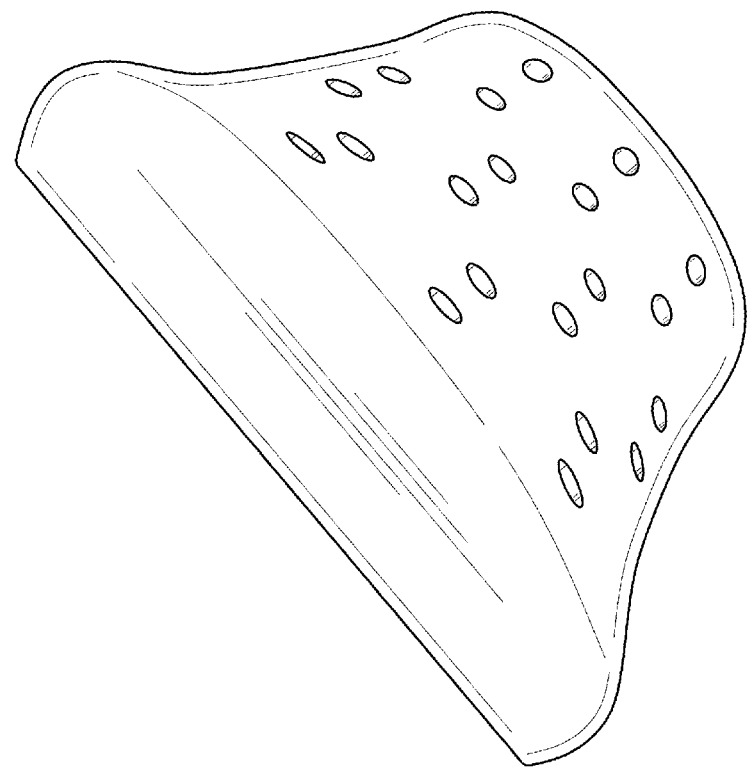

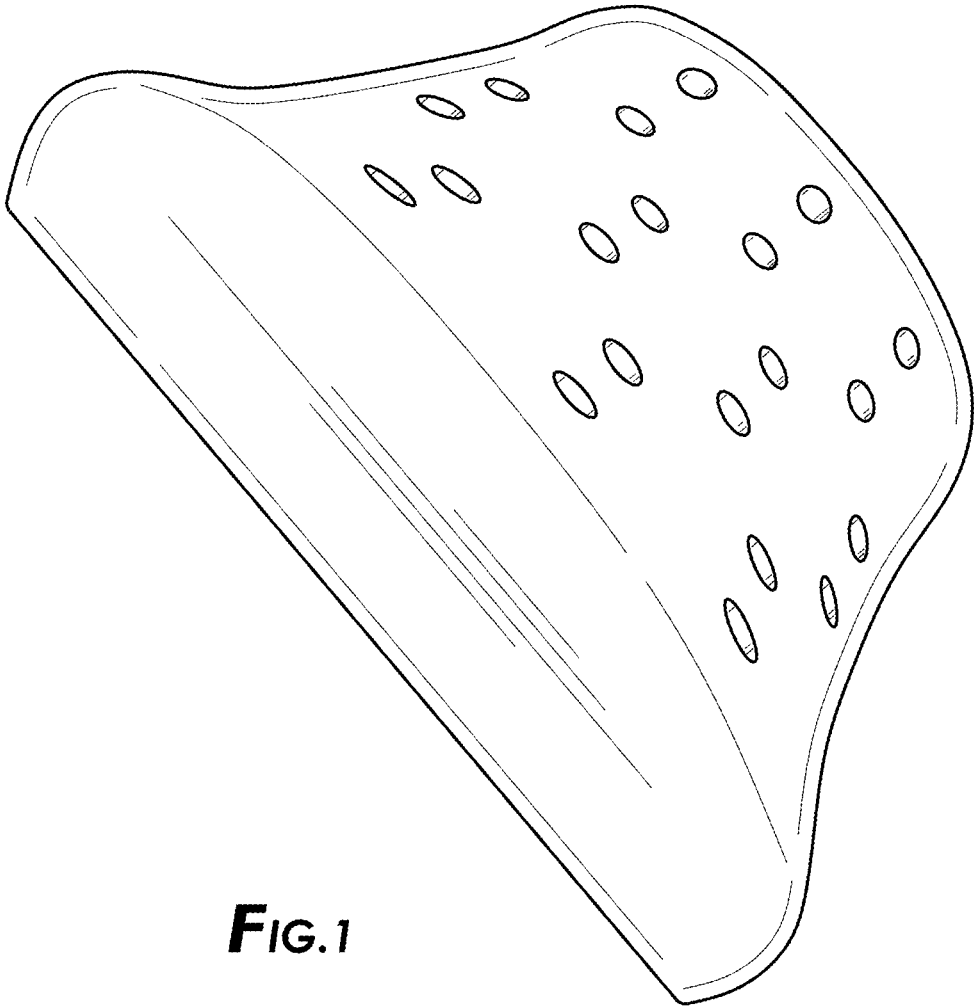
The ornamental design for a back cushion, as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

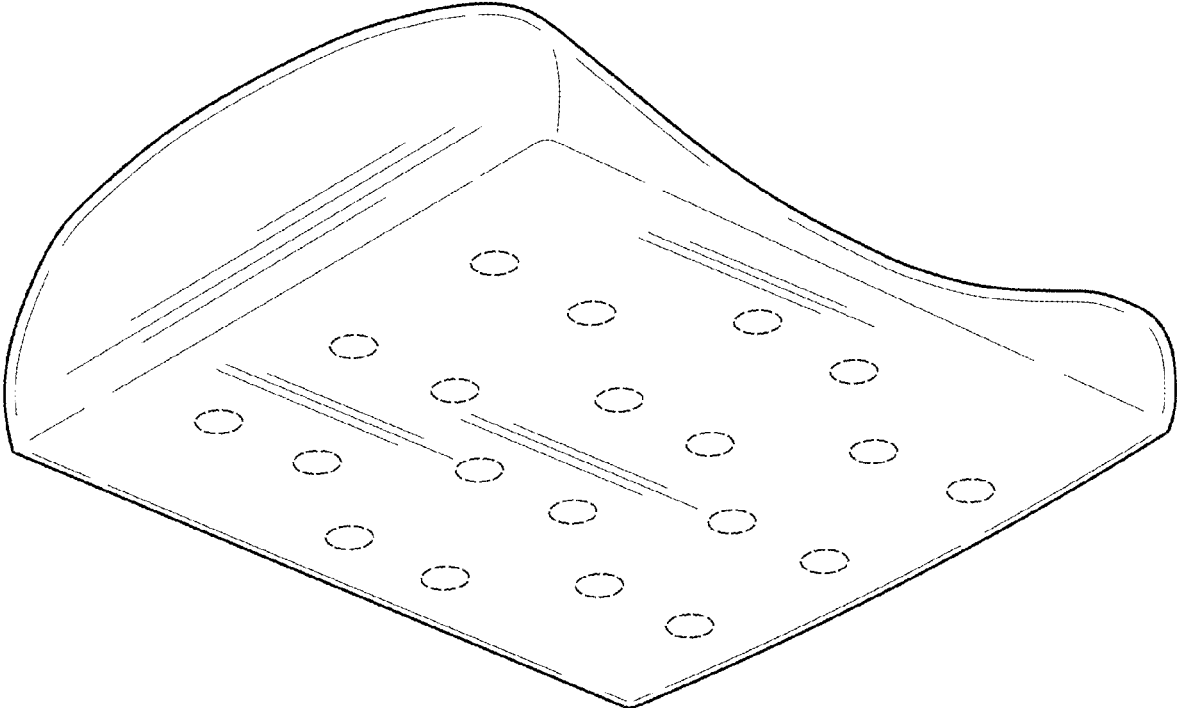

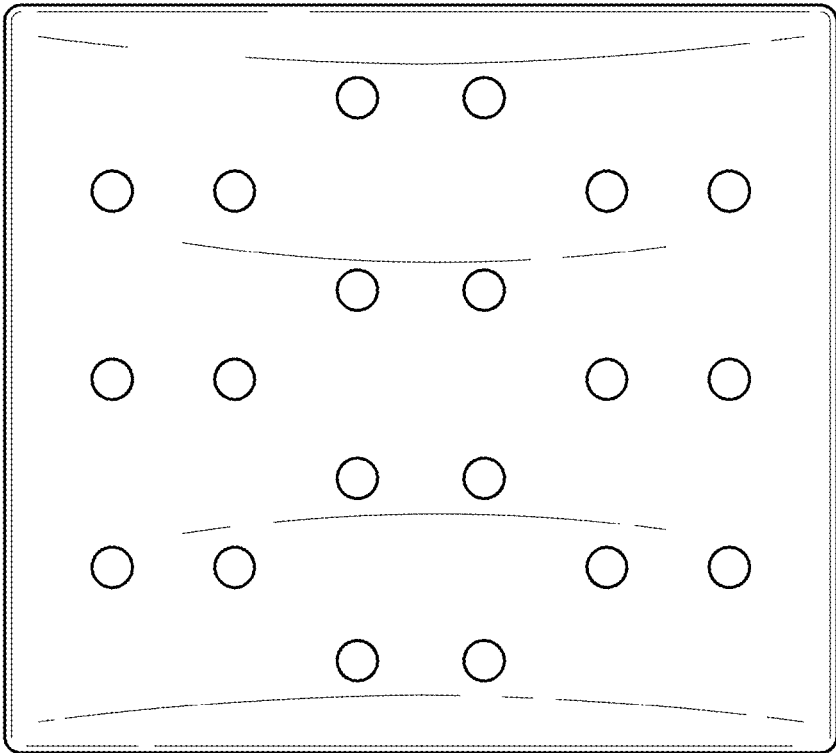




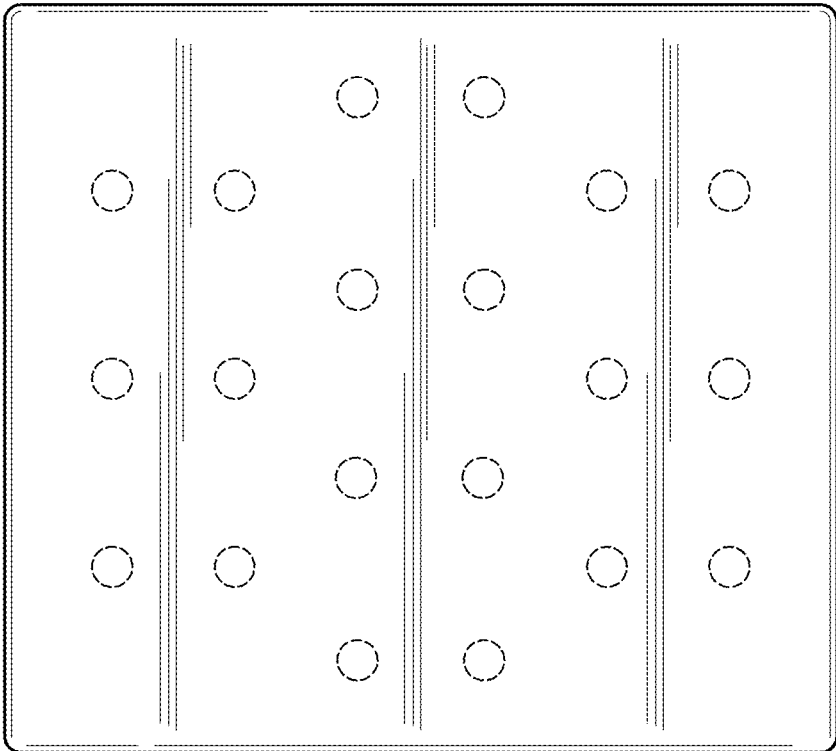

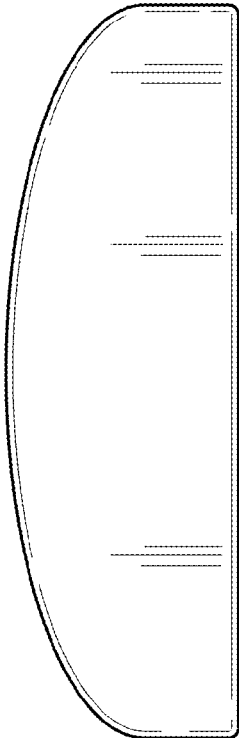

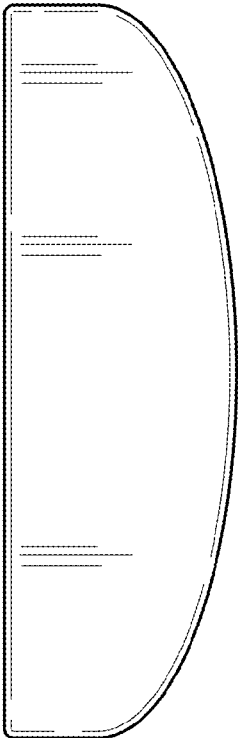

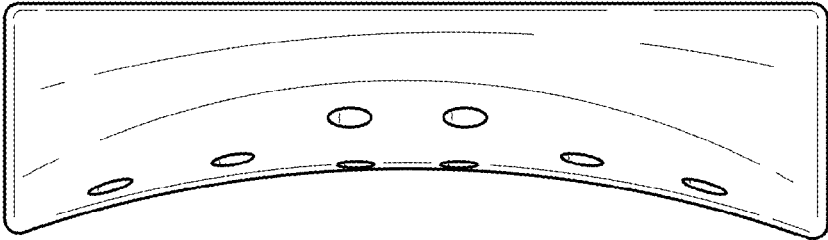

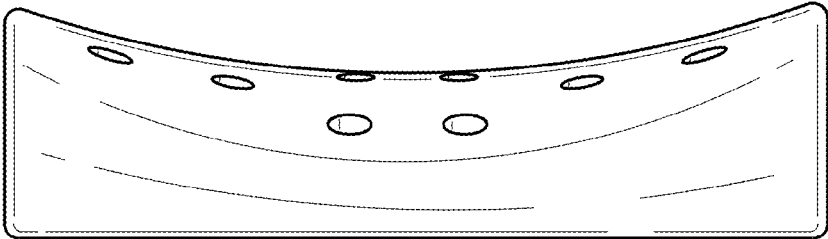
