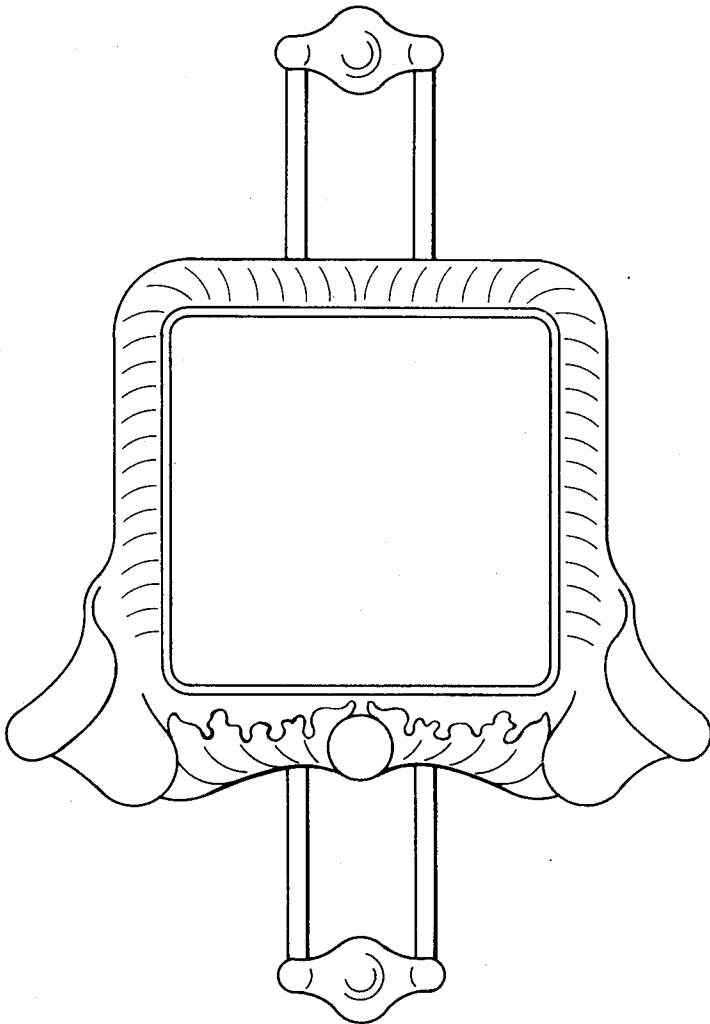
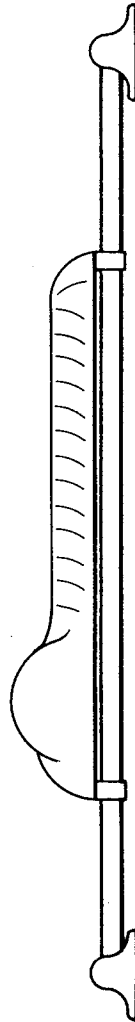

Be it known that I, FRANK WINTHROP DAVENPORT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Providence, in the county of Providence and State of Rhode Island, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Mirror-Frame, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—
