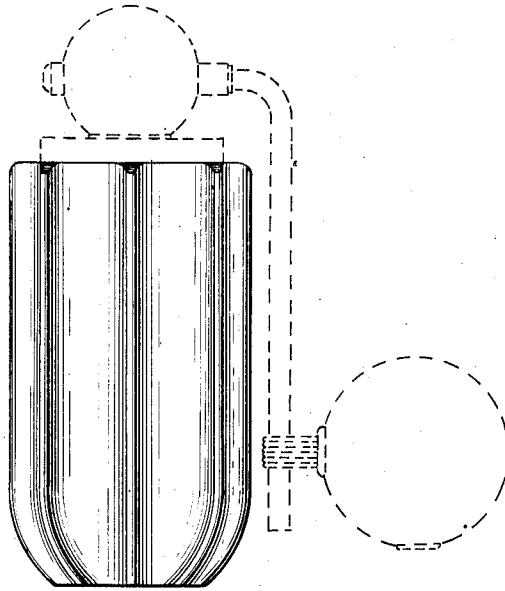

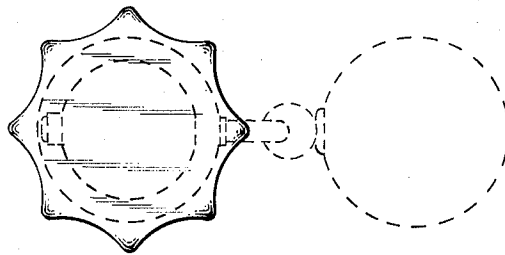

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Frederic A. Vuillemenot, a citizen of the United States, residing at 2441 Westbrook Drive, Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for an atomizer, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of an atomizer, showing my new design; and Fig. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

The essential features of my new design reside in the portions shown in full lines.
