


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM A. COLLINS, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city of New York, borough of Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Kite, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.
