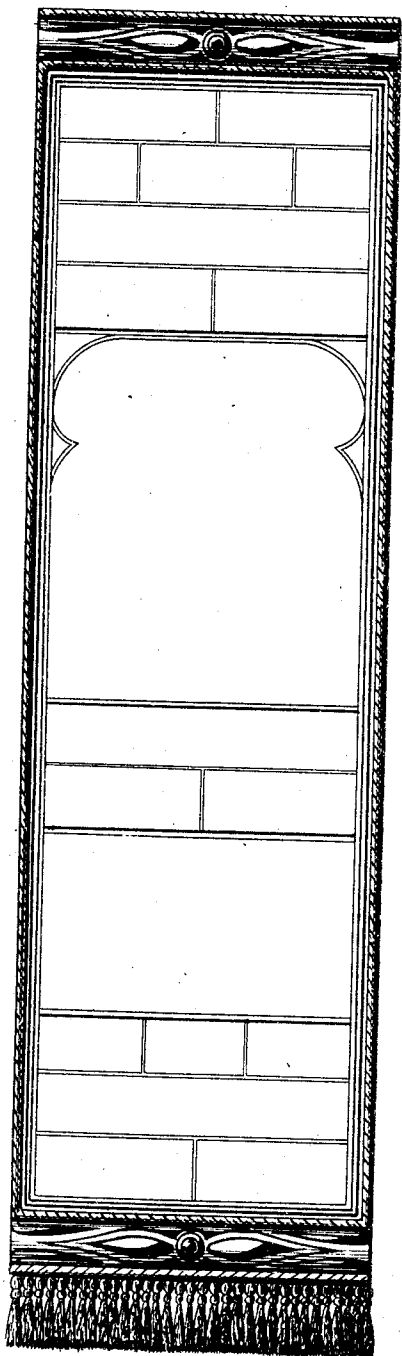

## DESIGN FOR A BANNER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,422, dated May 2, 1905.

Application filed March 13, 1905. Serial No. 249,962. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOHN R. EVANS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Denver, in the county of Denver and State of Colorado, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Banners, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
