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The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent, and making part of the same

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To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Conrad Harris and Paul W^m Zinner, both of Cincinnati, County of Hamilton, State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new and useful design for a dining room or over parlor stove, and we do hereby declare the following to be a full and exact description of the same—reference being had to the annexed drawings and to the letters of reference marked thereon, in which letter—E, represents a perspective view of the stove.

What we claim therein as new and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the combinations and arrangements of the figures, scrolls and foliage as set forth in the annexed drawings, forming a new and original design for dining room or over parlor stoves, to be known and called the Black Swan.
