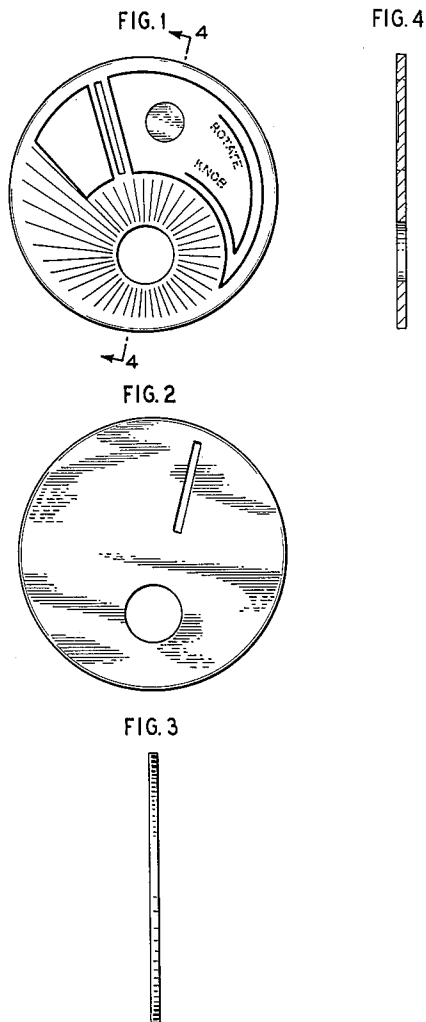


FIG. 1 is a plan view of an escutcheon, showing our new design;
