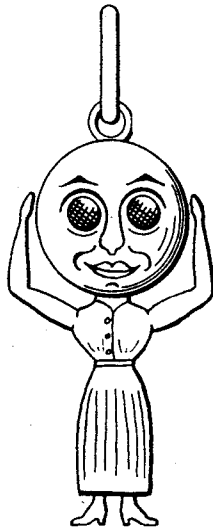

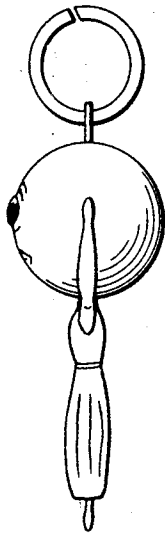

DESIGN FOR A CHARM.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HENRY BRANDON, a subject of the King of Great Britain, residing at Southampton House, 317 High Holborn, in the county of London, England, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Charms, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front view of a charm showing my new design, and Fig. 2 is a side view of Fig. 1.

The said charm comprises a female figure with a wooden head fitted with mineral eyes.
