



*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALEXANDER JASON DENISOFF, a citizen of the United States, residing at Ardsley, in the county of Westchester and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Match and Ash Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
