

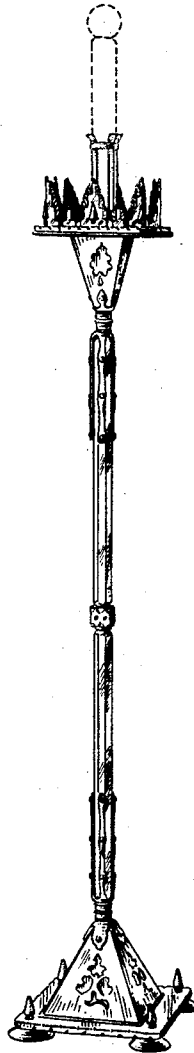

DESIGN FOR A TORCHÈRE.

Application filed December 11, 1926. Serial No. 20,020. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:
